THE FOREST DISEASE CONTROL REGULATIONS 1967
AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF "INFECTED AREA" IN RESPECT OF PINE NEEDLE BLIGHT (*Dothistroma pini*)

PURSUANT to the Forest Disease Control Regulations 1967, I, Allan Priestley Thomson, Director-General of Forests, Wellington, hereby amend the Declaration of Infected Area in respect of the forest disease pine needle blight (*Dothistroma pini*) that came into force on the 5th day of September 1967, as published in the *Gazette* of the 21st day of September 1967 and amended first by an amendment that came into force on the 23rd day of November 1967, as published in the *Gazette* of the 14th day of December 1967, and secondly by an amendment that came into force on the 5th day of March 1969, as published in the *Gazette* of the 27th day of March 1969, as follows:

Subparagraph 1 (c) is hereby deleted and the following subparagraph is substituted therefor—

“(c) (i) All that area in the North Auckland Land District situated in the Whangarei County and described generally as follows:
