The "normal" refers to the present site of the instruments. The standard periods for normals are: for temperature 1931-60, for rainfall 1921-50, and for sunshine 1935-60. No normals are available for stations with only short records.

*The sunshine recorder is not located at the station but is in the near vicinity.

A "rain day" is a day with rainfall equal to or greater than 0.1 mm.

NOTES ON THE WEATHER FOR JULY 1972

General—In contrast with the previous month, July was mild, and temperatures were warmer than in June by about 1°c, which is unusual. Some growth was still reported in the north, and stock were wintering fairly well. Lambing commenced in some districts under favourable conditions.

Rainfall—Rainfall was somewhat above normal over the greater part of the South Island, in Wellington and most of Manawatu, and west of the main ranges from Taihape to inland Bay of Plenty and Waikato, but not in Taranaki. It was somewhat below normal in eastern districts from North Canterbury to Gisborne, in Northland, and also in parts of Otago and Southland.

The wettest period was from the 9th to the 11th.

Temperatures—Temperatures were mainly above normal by 1° c but they were only about normal in coastal districts of Southland, Otago, and South Canterbury.

Sunshine—Sunshine was close to the normal value over the greater part of the South Island, in eastern districts of the North Island, and in Bay of Plenty and Taupo. Western districts of the North Island with Auckland and Northland and also Marlborough were favoured with 20–40 hours above normal. In Southland and Central and South Otago sunshine was mainly below normal by 20 hours.

Weather Sequence—On the first two days of July a depression passed close to Macquarie and Campbell Islands and another depression developed over the mid Tasman Sea, while troughs of low pressure crossed the country. Rain was fairly general except on the east coast from Dunedin to Napier. Some considerable falls were reported in Waikato and Bay of Plenty and on the West Coast. As the troughs moved away on the 3rd the weather improved but some rain was still reported in South Westland and Fiordland. During the 4th and 5th an anticyclone passed to the South of the South Island while a depression formed to the east of Northland and moved south-eastward. In the south-easterlies rain fell on the east coast from Timaru to East Cape and about Cook Strait. On the following day the anticyclone covered the whole country and the weather was fair but cold. With the development of a depression over the North Tasman Sea some light rain was reported in northern districts on the 7th and 8th.

The depression moved southward and deepened. From the 9th to the 11th it moved slowly eastward to a position off the Buller coast, while a trough of low pressure crossed New Zealand and another small centre developed to the east. This was the wettest part of the month, with general rain, except in the south-west of the South Island. Some considerable falls were reported in northern and western districts of both Islands. As the depression lost intensity on the following day the rain became lighter, but still

covered three-quarters of the country. During the 13th and 14th depressions passed far to the south with troughs of low pressure crossing New Zealand. Conditions were westerly with fairly general rain, which was however very light in the east. From the 15th to the 17th a deep depression over the Tasman Sea crossed the country just south of Cook Strait. Rain spread over the country, mainly from the north, and became general, while temperatures were colder. As the depression moved away on the following day rain persisted on the West Coast and the Southland coast with scattered light falls in other western districts, and in Otago and Southland. On the 19th, a ridge of high pressure covered the country and the weather was fair apart from some rain in South Westland and

At first, light rain was fairly general but on the 24th, in the south-casterlies, it was restricted mainly to Cook Strait, eastern districts from Cape Palliser to East Cape, Auckland, and Northland. From the 25th to the 27th an anti-cyclone was centered over the Tasman Sea and another developed east of the South Island, while the depression remained to the north-east of the North Island. The weather was settled apart from light rain at times in Northland, Gisborne and Hawke's Bay, and also South Westland. Southland and Fiordland Temperatures and also South Westland, Southland, and Fiordland. Temperatures became colder.

During the last four days of the month an anticyclone remained centered near the Chatham Islands, while another anticyclone was centered south-east of Tasmania, and a depression near Norfolk Island moved eastward. At first winds were mainly easterly with rain in many eastern districts from Canterbury northward, but later they were cold south-westerlies with only scattered light rain in some eastern and southern areas.
