HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wildlife Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Rotorua, Waimarino, and Wanganui Acclimatisation Districts Alteration Order 1972.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The boundaries of the Rotorua Acclimatisation District which was constituted by Warrant on the 19th day of August 1964 (*New Zealand Gazette* of 20 August 1964, at p. 1323), the boundaries of Waimarino Acclimatisation District constituted by Warrant on the 21st day of October 1964 (*New Zealand Gazette* of 5 November 1964, at p. 2013), and the boundaries of the Wanganui Acclimatisation District constituted by Warrant on the 21st day of October 1964 (*New Zealand Gazette* of 5 November 1964, at p. 2013), are hereby altered and redefined and as from the commencement of this order, the boundaries of the said districts shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

ROTORUA ACCLIMATISATION DISTRICT

ALL that area in the South Auckland, Gisborne, Wellington, and Hawke's Bay Land Districts, bounded by a line commencing at the middle of the mouth of the Mohaka River in Block XIII, Waihua Survey District, and proceeding up the middle of that river to a point in line with Trig. Station 68A in Block XIII, Kaweka Survey District, and Trig. Station 65A in Block XXI, Kaweka Survey District; thence southerly along a right line to the said Trig. Station 65A; thence westerly along right lines to Trig. Station 26, Tauwhaketewhango, in Block XII, Mangamaire Survey District, to Trig. Station 27 Motumatai, in Block XV, Mangamaire Survey District, to Trig. Station 28 Manukaiapu, in Block XVI, Kaimanawa Survey District, to Trig. Station N Ruapehu, in Block XI, Ruapehu Survey District, to Trig. Station H Paretaitonga, in Block XI, Ruapehu Survey District, and to Trig. Station C Hauhungatahi, in Block V, Ruapehu Survey District; thence northerly along a right line to a point in the middle of the Whakapapa River distant 200 metres down stream from the Whakapapa-Mangatepopo Tunnel Intake in Block IX, Tongariro Survey District, along a right line to a point in the middle of the Okupata Stream distant 200 metres down stream from the Okupata drop-shaft of the aforesaid tunnel in Block VII, Tongariro Survey District, down the middle of the Okupata Stream to the middle of the Wanganui River and up the middle of that river to a point in line with the western boundary of Waione Block in Block XIV, Maungaku Survey District; thence northerly to and along that boundary to Trig. Station 1545 Maungaku, in Block X, Maungaku Survey District; thence northerly along the summit of the Hauhungaroa Range passing through Trig. Stations, 1711 Hauhungaroa, in Block XIV, Puketapu Survey District, Motere, in Block V, Puketapu Survey District, 2019 Tuhingamata, in Block II, Puketapu Survey District, and 2016, Weraroa, in Block XI, Hurakia Survey District, to Trig. Station 1390 Pureora, in Block III, Hurakia Survey District; thence north-westerly along a right line to Pukeroa Trig. Station in Block XIV, Ranganui Survey District; thence north-easterly along the watershed between

the Waiteti and the Mangakino Streams to Trig. Station Taupaki in Block I, Whakamaru Survey District; thence easterly along a right line to Maraetai Dam on the Waikato River in Block II, Whakamaru Survey District; thence north-easterly along a right line to Trig. Station 1002 in Block XV, Patetere South Survey District; thence due east to a right line between Pureora Trig. Station aforesaid and Puwhenua Trig. Station in Block VII, Tapapa East Survey District; thence north-easterly along that right line to Puwhenua Trig. Station; thence north-westerly along a right line in the direction of Te Weraiti Trig. Station in Block IV, Opoutihi Survey District, to a point due west of Otanewainuku Trig. Station in Block XVI, Otanewainuku Survey District; thence due east through Otanewainuku Trig. Station to a point due south of Trig. Station II in Block IV, Waihi South Survey District; thence due north through Trig. Station II to the mean low-water mark of the sea; thence easterly and southerly along the mean low-water mark, crossing the mouths of all harbours and rivers, to the point of commencement, including Rurima Rocks, Whale Island, White Island, and all other adjacent islands.

WAIMARINO ACCLIMATISATION DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District bounded by a line commencing at the confluence of the Ongarue and Wanganui Rivers at Taumarunui and proceeding up the middle of the Wanganui River to and up the middle of the Okupata Stream to a point distant 200 metres down stream from the Okupata drop-shaft of the Whakapapa-Mangatepopo Tunnel in Block VII, Tongariro Survey District; thence southerly along a right line to a point in the middle of the Whakapapa River distant 200 metres down stream from the Whakapapa intake of the aforesaid tunnel in Block IX, Tongariro Survey District, and along a right line to Trig. Station C Hauhungatahi, in Block V, Ruapehu Survey District; thence easterly along right lines to Trig. Station H Paretaitonga, in Block XI, Ruapehu Survey District, to Trig. Station N Ruapehu, in Block XI, Ruapehu Survey District, and to Trig. Station 28 Manukaia, in Block XVI, Kaimanawa Survey District; thence south-westerly along right lines to Trig. Station XXIV, Te Rotete, in Block III, Moawhango Survey District, to Trig. Station C Auahitotara No. 2 in Block XI, Moawhango Survey District, and to the junction of State Highways No. 1 and No. 49 at Waiouru, and along the middle of State Highway No. 1, Waiarue Road, Owahakura Road, Whangaehu Valley Road, and Fields Track to the middle of State Highway No. 4; thence northerly along the middle of that highway to a point in line with the southern boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 29354; thence generally westerly to and along the southern boundaries of Lots 4 and 3, D.P. 29354, the eastern, northern, and western boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 29350, the south-eastern boundary of Lot 32, D.P. 29337, the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of Lot 42, D.P. 29337, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to and down the middle of Paparoa Stream to the middle of the Wanganui River; thence up the middle of that river to the point of commencement.

WANGANUI ACCLIMATISATION DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Wellington and Taranaki Land Districts commencing at a point in the middle of the mouth of the Waitotara River in line with the mean low-water mark of the sea and proceeding up the middle of that river to and up the middle of the Mangaone Stream and along the southern boundary of Section 28, Block V, Nukumarū Survey District, to Trig. Station Wharekarangi; thence generally easterly along the eastern boundary of the said section 28, the south-western boundaries of Lot 3, D.P. 659, and the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of Lot 4, D.P. 659, to Waitotara Road; thence generally northerly along a right line across that road to and along the south-western and north-western boundaries of Lot 14 and the western boundaries of Lot 17, D.P. 918, to Trig. Station Orangihoangi in Block II, Nukumarū Survey District; thence easterly along a right line to Trig. Station Pakira; thence generally northerly along the south-western, western, and northern boundaries of Manganuiotahu Block (crossing intervening roads), and the western boundaries of Lot 3, D.P. 2765, and Lot 1, D.P. 2764, to the north-western corner of the said Lot 1; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said Lot 1 and its production to the middle of Watershed Road; thence generally north-westerly along the middle of that road, Pipiriki Road, and Pokeko Road to the summit of the western watershed of the Wanganui River; thence northerly along that watershed passing through Trig. Station Maungarau in Block XII, Taurakawa Survey District, to Mount Humphries in Block III, Taurakawa Survey District; thence north-easterly along a right line in the direction of the confluence of the Tangarakau and Wanganui Rivers in Block XII, Mahoe Survey District, to the middle of the Wanganui River; thence generally southerly down the middle

of the Wanganui River to its confluence with Paparoa Stream in Block XI, Tauakira Survey District; thence generally easterly up the middle of that stream to and along the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of Lot 42, D.P. 29337, the south-eastern boundary of Lot 32, D.P. 29337, the western, northern, and eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 29350, the southern boundaries of Lots 3 and 4, D.P. 29354, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of State Highway No. 4; thence southerly along the middle of that highway to a point in line with the middle of Fields Track; thence generally north-easterly along the middle of Fields Track, Whangaehu Valley Road, and Owahakura Road to the middle of the Turakina River; thence down the middle of that river to a point in line with the low-water mark of the sea; thence north-westerly along that water mark, crossing the mouths of all harbours and rivers, to the point of commencement.

Northland Catchment Area Order 1972

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 and the Local Government Commission Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Northland Catchment Area Order 1972.

2. Extension of Northland Catchment Area—The area described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby included in the Northland Catchment Area.

3. Special provisions affecting part of the newly included area—In respect of that part of the Northland Catchment Area that comprises the area described in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the said area) the following provisions shall apply:

(a) The provisions of Part V of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 shall not apply:

Provided that they shall apply to the extent of any agreement to operate the whole or part of the said Part V made with the approval of the National Water and Soil Conservation Authority between the Northland Catchment Commission and any territorial local authority having jurisdiction in the said area in respect of the whole or any part of the district of that local authority.

(b) The provisions of section 126 of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 shall not apply:

Provided that they shall apply to the extent of any agreement to operate the provisions of such section made with the approval of the National Water and

Soil Conservation Authority between the Northland Catchment Commission and any territorial local authority having jurisdiction in the said area in respect of the whole or any part of the district of that local authority.

- (c) The provisions of subsection (2) of section 20 of the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 shall be restricted to conform with the provisions of paragraphs (a) to (d) of this clause.
- (d) Each territorial local authority having jurisdiction in the said area shall pay by way of an annual contribution towards the administrative costs incurred by the Northland Catchment Commission in carrying out its functions under the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 such sum or rate as may from time to time be fixed by any Act or regulation in that behalf and, until any such sum or rate has been so fixed, the amount to be so paid shall be such sum as may be agreed upon between the territorial local authority and the Northland Catchment Commission; and in the event of failure of any said territorial local authority and the Northland Catchment Commission to agree on any such sum, then such sum as may be determined by the National Water and Soil Conservation Authority:

In addition the Northland Catchment Commission may levy any of the said territorial local authorities having jurisdiction within the said area for the cost of any work undertaken or proposed to be undertaken for the purposes of the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 as hereinbefore restricted; and the cost of such work may be increased by a percentage to provide for administrative and other expenses in respect of the work as more particularly described in subsection (2) of section 84 of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 which for this purpose shall be read as if the references in that subsection were references to the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967, such percentage being from time to time determined by agreement between the Northland Catchment Commission and the said territorial local authority:

Provided that where an agreement as referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subclause is entered into the provisions of this paragraph (d) shall cease to operate or shall be modified to ensure compliance with the terms of the agreement.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, Rodney and Otamatea Counties, bounded by a line commencing at a point in Block IV, Mangawhai Survey District, on the line of mean high-water of the South Pacific Ocean at the easternmost corner of Allotment 107, Mangawhai Parish, and proceeding south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of that Allotment 107 to and southerly generally along the generally eastern boundaries of Section 37, and the last boundary produced to and westerly along the middle of Black Swamp Road, to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Section 8, Block IV, aforesaid; thence southerly along a right line to and along the eastern boundary, and south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 8, and the last boundary produced to the middle of Coal Hill Road; thence westerly and southerly along the middle of Coal Hill Road and Te Hana - Mangawhai Road, and the public road forming the eastern boundaries of Section 26, all the aforesaid sections being of Block IV, Mangawhai Survey District, and Allotment 281, Mangawhai Parish, and again Te Hana - Mangawhai Road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 24567, in Block I, Parkiri Survey District; thence easterly to and along that southern boundary and the northern boundaries of Allotments 90A and 97, to and southerly along the eastern boundary and westerly along the southern boundary of the said Allotment 97 and that boundary produced to the middle of Te Hana - Mangawhai Road, aforesaid; thence northerly generally along the middle of the said road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Allotment 90; thence westerly to and along the said boundary to and southerly along the western boundary of Allotment 92, and that boundary produced to the middle of Cames Road; thence westerly along the middle of the said road to a point in line with the western boundary of Allotment W93, all the aforesaid allotments being of Mangawhai Parish; thence southerly along a right line to and along that western boundary, to and along the northern and western boundaries of Allotment 9, Oruawhoro Parish, and that last boundary produced to the middle of the public road forming the southern boundaries of that Allotment 9; thence south-westerly generally along the middle of that public road and the public roads forming the north-eastern boundaries of Allotment N. 43, and the north-western boundaries of Allotments

N. 43, M. 43, N.W. 43, N.E. 50, N.E.M. 50, W. 50, 51, N.W. 53, N.E. 53, S. 53, N.W. 61, N.W. 71, S.E. 71, N.E. 72, N.E.M. 72, S.W.M. 72, S.W. 72, N.E. 76, S.W. 76, and 77, to and north-westerly along the middle of the public road forming the north-eastern boundary of Allotment 250, all the aforesaid allotments being of Oruawhoro Parish, to the eastern boundary of Otioro and Te Topuni Block; thence northerly along the said eastern boundary, to and westerly along the southern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 30610, in Block VIII, Otamatea Survey District, and that boundary produced to the middle of State Highway No. 1; thence northerly along the middle of the said State Highway, to and south-westerly along the middle of Ross Road and that middle line produced to the middle of the Newmarket-Opua Railway; thence northerly along the middle of that railway, to its junction with the right bank of a tributary of the Topuni River, in Block VII, Otamatea Survey District, shown on S.O. Plan 16358; thence north-westerly along the said right bank to the line of mean high-water of the Topuni River, in Block VII, aforesaid, and proceeding westerly generally along the line of mean high-water of the bays, inlets, and creeks of the Kaipara Harbour to the southern side of the public road forming the northern boundary of Section 17, Block I, Hukatere Survey District, thence easterly generally along the southern boundary of the Northland Catchment Area as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1962, p. 85, to its junction with the line of mean high-water of the South Pacific Ocean, in Block I, Mangawhai Survey District, thence southerly generally along the line of mean high-water of the South Pacific Ocean to the point of commencement including all adjacent islands in Harbours and Rivers.

as an officer of the Government of the Dependency; and I hereby confer on him all the powers and authorities which may be exercised in New Zealand by a Postmaster.

The said John Edward Brown to exercise his functions at such places within the Dependency as may be directed by the officer for the time being appointed as an officer of the Government of the Dependency in whom is vested the general executive and administrative authority in preserving Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty and the laws and regulations in force in the Dependency; and to hold office and exercise the duties thereof during pleasure.
