Amendment to Rules of the Wellington Stock Exchange

PURSUANT to section 11 of the Sharebrokers Act 1908, the Governor-General in Council on 1 October 1973 approved the following amendments to the rules of the Wellington Stock Exchange.

WELLINGTON STOCK EXCHANGE—AMENDMENT OF RULES

1. That rule 39 be amended by adding the following words: "including by way of explanation, but not by way of limitation, the power to enter into underwriting and sub-underwriting commitments in respect of any form of investment by any incorporated body or company which is officially listed or for which application has been made for official listing to the Stock Exchange Association of New Zealand".

2. That rule 60 be repealed and replaced by the following rule: "On application for transfer of membership, the whole amount of the purchase price shall be lodged with the Exchange. The committee may require from all or any of the parties concerned such evidence as they may deem necessary as to the price paid for the seat. Upon election 10 percent of the nominal value, for the time being of the seat, or 10 percent of the purchase price, whichever is the lesser, shall be retained by the Exchange and the balance of the purchase money shall be paid to the transferor. In the event of his rejection the amount of the purchase price paid shall be returned to the proposed transferee".

3. That rule 77 be amended by deleting the second paragraph thereof and substituting the following: "A member or firm of members which has obtained permission to have an authorised clerk or clerks shall pay an additional annual subscription calculated in respect of each authorised clerk equal to one-quarter of the subscription payable by a metropolitan member or such sum as may from time to time be determined by members in general meeting and shall be paid in the same manner and proportion as the annual subscription".

4. That rule 91 be amended by deleting the words and figures "Association rule 77", and substituting therefore the words "Association rules".

United Nations Security Council's Sanctions Committee's Appeal Concerning Southern Rhodesia

THE following communique issued by the Security Council's Sanctions Committee on 4 September 1973 is published for general information:

"An appeal for information from private individuals and non-governmental organisations as to possible sanctions violations is launched by the United Nations Security Council Committee established in pursuance of resolution 253 (1968) concerning the question of Southern Rhodesia.

As a Committee of the Security Council, its present membership is as follows: Australia, Austria, China, France, Guinea, India, Indonesia, Kenya, Panama, Peru, Sudan, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America and Yugoslavia. The Committee was established by the Security Council on 29 May 1968 when the Council unanimously approved mandatory sanctions against the illegal regime in Southern Rhodesia. This was the first time in the history of the United Nations that mandatory economic sanctions were imposed by the Security Council.

In the past the Committee has received information mainly from Government sources, which has enabled it to investigate many cases of suspected violations of sanctions. However, the Committee feels that there are sources of information regarding violations of sanctions which are not at present being tapped. Accordingly the Security Council agreed that Member States, as well as the Committee, should, by taking adequate measures, encourage individuals and non-governmental organisations to report to the concerned bodies reliable information concerning sanctions-breaking operations.

The Committee invites private individuals and organisations to supply it with reliable information on the following:

- (a) trade, or the promotion of trade, with Southern Rhodesia, including carriage of goods;
- (b) financial or investment transactions with Southern Rhodesia;
- (c) foreign travel by Southern Rhodesians;
- (d) transport to or from Southern Rhodesia;
- (e) encouragement of emigration or tourism to Southern Rhodesia;
- (f) the maintenance of any relations or any representation, official or unofficial, with Southern Rhodesia.

These activities, or any others liable to support or encourage the illegal regime, involve possible violation of sanctions and should be reported to national authorities and/or direct to the Committee. Reliable and detailed information is desirable.

Authorship of information sent to the Committee will, if desired, be treated as confidential. The Committee always meets in closed sessions and its records are available only to members of the Committee. The Committee hopes that communications addressed to it will be signed and fully attributable.
