PURSUANT to the Electricity Distribution Commission Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Constitution of the Rotorua Area Electricity Authority Order Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Constitution of the Rotorua Area Electricity Authority Order 1972 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal order").

2. The principal order is amended as follows:

- (a) by excluding from the land, firstly described in First Schedule thereto, all that area in the South Auckland Land District, County of Taupo, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the middle line of the Waikato River with the Southern boundary of Block V, Takapau Survey District, and proceeding generally south-westerly up the middle of that river to its intersection with the eastern boundary of Block XII, Tatua Survey District; thence northerly along that eastern boundary and easterly along the southern boundary of Block V, Takapau Survey District, to the point of commencement more particularly outlined red on the plan marked NZED 895 deposited in the office of the New Zealand Electricity Department at Wellington;

(b) by deleting from the First Schedule thereto all the land "thirdly" therein described and substituting the following:

"thirdly, all that area in South Auckland Land District, County of Taupo, bounded by a line commencing at Pokapoka Trig. in Block XIII, Kaingaroa Survey District, and proceeding north-westerly along the south-western boundary of part Run 57 (State Forest: *Gazette*, 1933, p. 1671), to and northerly along the eastern side of Goudie's Road to its intersection with a right line joining Trig. Station 31 (Paeroa), situated in Block V, Paeroa Survey District, and Trig. Station 76A (Tawhiwhau), in Block XIV, Galatea Survey District; thence easterly along that right line to its intersection with a right line produced southerly joining Trig. Station 18 (Maungawhakamana), in Block III, Ruawahia Survey District, and Trig. Station 38 (Ahiwhakamura), in Block X, Kaingaroa Survey District; thence along another right line to Trig. Station 78 (Pekepeke), in Block III, Wheao Survey District; thence southerly generally along a right line to Trig. Station 76 (Taupiri) in Block XII, Wheao Survey District, and another right line to Trig. Station F (Tiritiri) in Block III, Heruiwi Survey District; thence along another right line in the direction of Trig. Station B (Pukeroa), in Block XI, Heruiwi Survey District, to its intersection with the northern boundary of Block VII, Heruiwi Survey District; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of the aforesaid Block VII and Blocks VI and V, Heruiwi Survey District, the northern boundary of Block VIII, the eastern and northern boundaries of Block III, and the northern boundary of Block II, the aforesaid blocks being in Otukotara Survey District, to the western boundary of Run 60 (State Forest: *Gazette*, 1930, p. 2639); thence northerly generally along the aforesaid boundary and the generally western and northern boundaries of Run 59 (State Forest: *Gazette*, 1927, p. 2692) to the westernmost corner of Kaingaroa 1A South (State Forest: *Gazette*, 1929, p. 2488); thence along the western boundary of the aforesaid 1A South, to and along the western boundary of Run 58 (State Forest: *Gazette*, 1926, p. 2153) to Pokapoka Trig. the point of commencement; the said area being more particularly shown outlined by means of a blue dotted line on the plan marked NZED 580 deposited in the office of the New Zealand Electricity Department at Wellington."

*Potato Board Notice—Levy on Main Crop Potatoes*

PURSUANT to section 15 of the Potato Growing Industry Act 1950, and the regulations made thereunder, the Potato Board resolved on the 4th day of December 1973 that:

1. The levy prescribed and notified in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 10 February 1972, No. 13, p. 282, is hereby revoked as from 28 February 1974 and a new levy substituted therefor, as set out in the succeeding provisions hereto.

2. From and including 1 March 1974 a levy at the rate of \$1.20 per tonne of 1000 kg, and payable in accordance with this resolution, be payable by growers of main crop potatoes.

3. The levy shall be payable in respect of all main crop potatoes grown in all districts in New Zealand upon sale by the grower, whether as table potatoes or as seed potatoes, excepting only:

(a) Potatoes sold by the grower as "certified seed", that is packed in containers labelled with official certification tag of the Department of Agriculture, provided that the maximum certification grading size of such potatoes does not exceed 180 gram.

(b) Potatoes (other than "certified seed potatoes" as in (a) above), which are sold by the grower as seed, provided that the maximum size of such potatoes does not exceed 130 gram.

(c) Potatoes other than those specified in the preceding paragraphs (a) or (b) which are sold by the grower as seed and delivered direct to another grower for use for seed purposes.

(d) Potatoes sold by the grower for export as "Island Smalls" or as "Mediums"; provided that the maximum size of such potatoes does not exceed 130 gram.

4. Where any grower sells potatoes ungraded as to size which are not exempt under clause 3 hereof, 70 percent (70%) of the quantity sold shall be liable to the full levy prescribed in this resolution notwithstanding any subsequent grading thereof by the purchaser.

5. For the purpose of the proviso to clause 3 of this resolution, "grower" shall not include any person, firm, or company which has contracted in any manner whatsoever with the occupier of any land for the acquisition of any potatoes grown thereon.

6. For purposes of this levy notice and in compliance with paragraph (d) of subsection (6) of section 15 of the Potato Growing Industry Act 1950, it shall be deemed that:

"Table potatoes" means all potatoes of any quality, size, and condition intended for human consumption, and

"Seed potatoes" means all potatoes of any quality, size, and condition intended to be used as seed potatoes for planting.

*Tariff and Development Board Notice No. 393—Inquiry Concerning Protection for New Zealand Industry Producing Carpet Joining Tape of Glass Fibre Fabrics—Public Hearing*

*Tariff and Development Board Notice No. 395—Inquiry Concerning Protection for New Zealand Industry Manufacturing Unsintered Polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE) Tape—Public Hearing*

1. Following receipt by the Minister of Customs of a report from the Emergency Protection Authority on his inquiry into the question of temporary protection for the New Zealand industry manufacturing unsintered polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE) tape, the Minister notified the Board in a letter dated 5 December 1973 that the Authority had concluded that urgent action was necessary to protect the local industry and had recommended the imposition of a temporary additional duty representing the amount by which the f.o.b. price was less

than \$1.45 per square metre, or \$1.21 per square yard. He had also recommended that the additional duty should not be applied to tape of Australian origin. Since the Authority had reported, there had been a number of changes in the price structures of both the locally manufactured and the imported tape and Government had decided not to accept the Authority's recommendation. However it had accepted his conclusion that urgent action was necessary to protect the position of the local manufacturer and this had been effected by the re-imposition of import licensing control.

2. The Minister of Customs has requested the Board to undertake an inquiry and report, with the object of providing Government with a basis for restructuring and updating the Tariff to establish, where possible, adequate rates of duty protection in respect of unsintered PTFE tape classified within Tariff item 39.02.111.

3. For the purpose of taking evidence the Board will hold a public hearing in the Hearing Room, Eighth Floor, Cumberland House, Upper Willis Street, Wellington, on Tuesday, 16 July 1974 commencing at 10.30 a.m.

4. The attention of interested parties is drawn to the fact that the Board may find it appropriate to comment upon and compare the relative merits of protection by means of tariff rates and import licensing when used jointly or separately.
