**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Finance Companies (Government Stock) Order 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Finance Companies (Government Stock) Order 1973\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

**2. Minimum percentage of government stock to be held by finance companies**—(1) Clause 3 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words “and every succeeding quarter”.

(2) Clause 3 of the principal order is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(c) On the 1st day of April 1974, and at all times during that quarter and every succeeding quarter, 10 per cent.”

PURSUANT to the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. This order shall come into force on 1 April 1974.

2. The areas described in the First Schedule hereto shall be included in the inner area of the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage District.

3. The area described in the Second Schedule hereto shall be excluded from the inner area of the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage District.

### FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, County of Waitemata, in Block XIV, Waitemata Survey District, bounded by a line commencing at the southernmost corner of Lot 10, D.P. 56847; thence proceeding south-westerly along a right line across Lots 2 and 1, D.P. 44586; Lot 2, D.P. 33907; part Lot 24, D.P. 1467; Lot 1, D.P. 60049; and Lot 1, D.P. 43647 to the easternmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. 29250; thence along the south-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 29250 and Lot 1, D.P. 41584 and that boundary produced across part Lot 8, D.P. 7398; Lot 9, D.P. 7398 and Simpsons Road to the western side of that road; thence northerly

All that area in the North Auckland Land District, County of Waitemata, Block XIV, Waitemata Survey District, bounded by a line commencing at the easternmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. 56847, and proceeding north-easterly along a right line parallel to the southeastern side of Metcalfe Road to its junction with the southern side of the Newmarket-Opua Railway; thence westerly and south-westerly along the boundary of the inner area of the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage District as described in the Third Schedule of Section 4 of the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage Act 1960, to a point in line with the southwestern side of Munroe Road; thence along a right line across Metcalfe Road to and along the boundary of the inner area of the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage District as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1969, p. 1714, to the point of commencement.

All that area in the North Auckland Land District, City of Manukau, in Blocks IX and X, Otahuhu Survey District, bounded by a line commencing at the southernmost corner of Lot 16, D.P. 61861, thence proceeding southerly along the eastern boundary of Lot 5, D.P. 55319, to and south-westerly generally, along the right bank of the Pukaki Creek, to and northerly generally, along the left bank of the Waokauri Creek to the northern boundary of part Lot 3, D.P. 55319, thence south-easterly and south-westerly along the boundary of the inner area of the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage District as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1971, p. 393, to the point of commencement.

*Amendment to Rules of Marlborough Acclimatisation Society*

PURSUANT to section 29 of the Wildlife Act 1953, the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby gives notice that he has approved the following new rules made by the Marlborough Acclimatisation Society to stand in place of Rules 6 and 9 respectively as originally approved by the Minister of Internal Affairs on 12 September 1956:

6. Only those persons who were members of the Society on the 31st day of August immediately preceding the date appointed for the holding of the annual general meeting shall be entitled to vote at any ballot for the election of officers of the Society, and for the purposes of every such ballot the register of members shall be closed as at the said 31st day of August.

9. The election of councillors shall be by postal ballot conducted in the following manner:

- (a) The Secretary shall on or before the 30th day of September advertise not less than twice in a daily newspaper circulating in the District all vacancies to be filled at the annual general meeting and calling for nominations to fill all such vacancies.
- (b) Nomination for office shall be in writing signed by the proposer and seconder and containing the nominee's written acceptance and all shall be members of the Society on the 31st day of August prior to the election. Nominations must be in the hands of the Secretary not later than 5 p.m. on a day to be fixed by him being a day between the 1st day of October and 31st day of October.
- (c) Not less than 14 clear days before the date of the annual general meeting the Secretary shall forward to each member at his last known mailing address a ballot paper containing the name, occupation, and address of every nominee for office. The names of retiring councillors offering themselves for re-election shall be indicated by an asterisk. The ballot papers shall contain clear instructions on how to vote and state that the voting papers are returnable to the Secretary, in an envelope marked Ballot Paper, and must be received by him on or before a date to be fixed by him and notified on the ballot paper, such a day to be within the month of November and prior to the annual general meeting. The instructions on how to vote shall contain the following instructions:

"Each member shall leave *uncancelled* the name of any candidate for whom he desires to vote and shall *strike* out the name of any candidate for whom he does not desire to vote. Each member shall vote for the full number of candidates required to fill all positions and any voting paper failing to comply shall be classified invalid. The voting paper shall be signed by the voter."

The non-receipt of any ballot paper by a member or the accidental omission of any ballot paper to any member shall not invalidate the election.

- (d) Any ballot paper or envelope so marked received by the Secretary after the specified date shall be enfaced with the particulars of the date and time of the receipt by the Secretary and shall be disregarded in counting the ballot and may be destroyed at the expiration of one month after the date of the annual general meeting.
- (e) On receipt of the completed ballot papers and ballot envelopes, other than those received after the specified date, the Secretary shall hand them unopened to two scrutineers appointed by the Council and receive a receipt from them for the total number of ballot papers or ballot envelopes. The scrutineers shall then in the presence of each other count the ballot and deliver to the Secretary prior to the opening of the annual general meeting a certificate signed by each of them declaring the result of the ballot papers under sealed cover. The certificate of such scrutineers shall be conclusive. In the event of a tie for the last vacant seat on Council

the matter shall be decided by lot. The ballot papers may be destroyed on the expiry of one month from the date of the annual general meeting.

- (f) The Chairman of the meeting shall, immediately following the adoption of the annual report and balance sheet, read out the names of the members successful in the ballot and the number of votes received by each candidate and declare them elected to the Council for the prescribed period of office.
- (g) Unless at a meeting of the Council, held prior to the Secretary calling for nominations in accordance with Rule 9 (a) hereof, it should be resolved that this rule shall not apply to that election, then each candidate shall supply to the Secretary a personal statement having reference to his candidature, such personal statement shall be, as nearly as may be, biographical in form and shall consist of not more than 40 words nor less than 20 words in addition to the candidate's name, occupation, and address. The Secretary may then take such steps as he deems necessary to promulgate such statements to members.
- (h) Subject only to the provision of Rule 9 (g) hereof, no canvassing or touting shall be allowed. Any breach of this rule by a candidate or with his acquiescence or consent shall be deemed to disqualify the candidate from election.

Disqualification of any candidate under this rule shall not operate to invalidate the voting paper under Rule 9 (c) hereof but the votes thereon for the disqualified candidate shall be disregarded.

2. The basis of calculating the amount of grants made for general administration to the governing body of any school in accordance with the provisions of the Secondary School Grants Regulations 1974, S.R. 1974/23, shall be as follows:

- (a) A grant payable in accordance with paragraph (a) of regulation 4 of the said regulations in respect of the number of pupils enrolled in each school under the control of the governing body shall be calculated as follows:

At any time after the Bill introduced into the Parliament of the United Kingdom has become law, under the provisions of the proposed New Zealand Act, the Company will be enabled to deliver to the Registrar of Companies at Wellington certain documents specified in the Act and apply for the issue of a certificate of incorporation and thereupon the Company will be deemed to be incorporated under the Companies Act 1955. The Company will be deemed to be the same company as the Company existing under the Companies Acts 1948 to 1967 of the United Kingdom, and the continuity, status, and operation of the Company will in no way be affected nor will any property, powers, rights, authorities, duties, functions, liabilities or obligations of the company or any legal or other proceedings instituted or to be instituted by or against the Company be affected.
