## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 25th day of March 1974

Present:

THE HON. H. WATT PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Ohawe Beach and Waihi Beach Foreshore Control Order 1974.

2. This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

3. The Ohawe and Waihi Beach Foreshore Control Order 1968\*, is hereby revoked.

4. In this order:

"Foreshore" means such parts of the bed, shore, or banks of a tidal water as are covered and uncovered by the flow and ebb of the tide at ordinary spring tides;

"Minister" means the Minister of Transport, and includes any officer, person or authority acting by or under the direction or authority of the Minister;

"Act" means the Harbours Act 1950.

5. There is hereby granted for a period of 10 years from the commencement of this order to the persons appointed beach rangers, under the Harbours Act 1950, for the Ohawe and Waihi Beaches (hereinafter called the Trustees) the control of the foreshore described in the First Schedule to this

order, subject to the provisions of section 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, and to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule to this order.

### FIRST SCHEDULE

#### DESCRIPTION OF FORESHORE

ALL that part of the foreshore of the County of Hawera commencing at the south bank of the Waingongoro Stream and extending generally in a south-easterly direction to a point 4 miles distant.

### SECOND SCHEDULE

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Her Majesty or the Governor-General and all officers in the Government service acting in the execution of their duty shall at all times have a free ingress, passage, and egress into, over, and out of the foreshore described in the First Schedule hereto.

2. Nothing herein contained shall authorise the Trustees to do or cause to be done anything repugnant to or inconsistent with any law relating to the Customs, or any regulation of the Minister of Customs, or with any provision of the Harbours Act 1950, or its amendments, or any regulations made thereunder that are or may hereafter be in force.

3. The rights, powers, and privileges conferred by this Order in Council shall not apply to those portions of the foreshore required for securing the shore ends of any telegraph cables that are at present or may be at any time laid down within the area of foreshore described in the First Schedule to this order.

4. Fees and other charges received from licenses and permits that may be issued by the Trustees, pursuant to section 165 (3) of the Act, shall be expended on facilities and amenities for public recreation on the foreshore and adjacent public areas.

5. The Trustees may enclose any part or parts of the foreshore, described in the First Schedule of this order, for the purpose of holding athletic sports or games and may, by bylaws, fix a charge for admission to such enclosed part or parts; provided that the total number of days on which such enclosures are made shall not exceed 6 in any one year.

6. Nothing herein contained shall authorise the Trustees to remove or cause to be removed any stone, sand, single, or shells without the consent of the Minister being first obtained.

7. The said rights, powers, and privileges may be at any time resumed by the Governor-General, without payment or any compensation whatever, on giving to the Trustees 6 calendar months notice in writing. Any such notice shall be sufficient if given by the Minister and delivered at or posted to the last-known address of the Trustees in New Zealand.

PURSUANT to the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire District Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires,—
  - The "Act" means the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1955;
  - The "Committee" means the Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire Committee constituted by these regulations;
  - "District" means the Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire District.

#### PART I—CONSTITUTION OF INVERCARGILL RESERVES RURAL FIRE DISTRICT

3. The area specified in the Schedule to this order is hereby constituted and declared to be a rural fire district to be known as the Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire District.

4. The trees and other plants on lands described in the Schedule to this order are hereby specified as the property for the protection of which the district is constituted.

5. The period of the closed fire season is hereby declared to be continuous.

6. The Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire District shall be administered, for the purposes of the said Act, by the Invercargill City Council, and the said Invercargill City Council is hereby constituted as the rural fire committee of the Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire District for this purpose.

#### PART II—REGULATIONS

7. The Rural Fire Committee Regulations, shall, so far as they are applicable, and with the necessary modifications, apply to the Invercargill City Council as the rural fire committee of the Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire District; and these regulations shall be deemed to be special regulations for the purpose of those regulations.

##### SOUTHLAND LAND DISTRICT—SOUTHLAND CONSERVANCY

###### *Invercargill Reserves Rural Fire District*

Firstly, all that area in the Southland Land District, Southland County, containing approximately 2,300 acres, situated in Block XXII, Invercargill Hundred, and bounded generally as follows:

Towards the north by Section 18, the crossing of a public road, part of Section 7, a public road and other part of Section 7, Block XV, New River Hundred; towards the south and east generally by the western bank of the Oreti River to the intersection of Municipal Endowment, Section 5, Block XXIII, New River Hundred, thence south and west by the aforesaid section to the mean high water mark Foveaux Strait following in a north-westerly direction along Oreti Beach to the point of commencement.

**WELLINGTON METHODIST CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL TRUSTS AMENDMENT BILL**

**NOTICE OF PRIVATE BILL**

THE Board of the Wellington Methodist Charitable and Educational Endowments incorporated under the Wellington Methodist Charitable and Educational Trusts Act 1916 (Private), gives notice of its intention to apply for leave to bring into the House of Representatives the above-intituled Bill the objects of which are as follows:

First, to alter the ending of the financial year of the Board from the last day of December to the last day of June in each year and thus correspond more closely with the annual Conference of the Methodist Church to which the Board makes annual report.

Secondly, to extend the present powers of sale which with the approval of the Methodist Conference are restricted to sale by auction or public tender to enable the Board subject to the approval of the said Conference to sell land in such manner and on such terms as the Board thinks fit. The proceeds of sale are to be available for purchase by the Board of any other estate freehold, leasehold, or stratum in New Zealand either in the Board's own name or jointly with any other agency of the Methodist Church. The proceeds may also be used in making permanent improvements upon other land of the Board or in the execution of works of subdivision development or improvement of any such land held by the Board or may be invested on deposit with any Savings Society or Trust established by or with the consent of the Methodist Conference.

Thirdly, the purposes of the Bill are to extend the powers of investment of the Board's money in investments authorised under the Trustee Act 1956, or in securities of any company officially listed on the Stock Exchange in New Zealand which comprise shares, stock or debentures secured or unsecured notes but not including such shares, stock debentures, or notes not fully paid up unless required to be fully paid within 12 months after the date of issue nor is investment to be allowed in notes or debentures in respect of which any liability to make further advances or payments will remain after the expiration of twelve months after the date of acquisition. There is a further restriction on investment in securities of companies unless the company has a paid up share capital of \$1,000,000 or more and if the company has not paid a dividend of at least 5 percent in each complete financial year within 5 years prior to the date of investment. No investment is to be made in any company whose business might conflict with the general rules and usages of the Methodist Church of New Zealand.

Finally, the Bill makes provision for use of income from investments in aid of homes, schools, colleges, or other institutions established or supported by the Methodist Conference.
