WHEREAS, by the Order in Council dated the 30th day of July 1923\*, made under the British Settlements Act 1887 of the United Kingdom Parliament, the Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of New Zealand for the time being (therein and hereinafter called the Governor) was appointed to be the Governor of the Ross Dependency, and all the powers and authorities which by the said order were given and granted to the Governor for the time being of the Dependency were thereby vested in him:

And whereas the Governor was thereby further authorised and empowered to make all such rules and regulations as might lawfully be made by Her Majesty's authority for the peace, order, and good government of the Dependency:

And whereas, by regulations made by the Governor on the 14th day of November 1923†, it was enacted that all persons appointed by the Governor for the time being of the Dependency should have such power and authority as might be granted them in due course of law, and might be empowered to do such things as might be necessary or desirable to ensure that the laws in force in the Dependency are duly observed and complied with in every respect, and to do all things necessary or expedient for the peace, order, and good government of the Dependency, and to safeguard and preserve Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty over and in respect of the Dependency:

And whereas it is expedient that the persons hereinafter named be appointed officers of the Government of the Dependency:

Now, therefore, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, and as such the Governor of the Ross Dependency, hereby appoint

James Arthur Newman, Esquire

as an officer of the Government of the Dependency; and I hereby confer on him all the powers and authorities which may be exercised in New Zealand by a Justice of the Peace, and also the powers and authorities which may be so exercised by a Coroner.

And I also appoint

Alan Leander John Campbell, Esquire

as an officer of the Government of the Dependency; and I hereby confer on him all the powers and authorities which may be exercised in New Zealand by a Postmaster.

The said James Arthur Newman and Alan Leander John Campbell to exercise their functions at such places within the Dependency as may be directed by the officer for the time being appointed as an officer of the Government of the Dependency in whom is vested the general executive and administrative authority in preserving Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty and the laws and regulations in force in the Dependency; and to hold office and exercise the duties thereof during pleasure.

*The Public Trust Office (Investment Agencies in Common Fund) Notice 1974*

PURSUANT to section 37 of the Public Trust Office Act 1957, the Minister of Finance hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Public Trust Office (Investment Agencies in the Common Fund) Notice 1974.  
(b) This notice shall come into force on the 15th day of September 1974.

2. The rate of interest that may be paid by the Public Trustee on moneys invested by the Public Trustee as agent of any principal in the common fund of the Public Trust Office, pursuant to section 37 of the Public Trust Office Act 1957, shall in each case be that which is agreed upon between the Public Trustee and the principal, but not exceeding:

- (a) 5½ percent per annum where the term of the agency is 1 year;
- (b) 6 percent per annum where the term of the agency is 2 years;
- (c) 7 percent per annum where the term of the agency is 3 years;
- (d) 7½ percent per annum where the term of the agency is 4 years.

3. Nothing in this notice shall be deemed to affect the rate of interest that may be paid on any moneys so invested before the date of the coming into force of this notice.

## New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement

PURSUANT to Article 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, the products listed in the following Schedule have been nominated by New Zealand and Australia for addition to Schedule A.

Prior to formal inclusion in Schedule A, interested persons or firms are invited to make representations in support of or against any nominated product or products. The representations should be forwarded to the Secretary, Tariff and Development Board, P.O. Box 27-046, Wellington, not later than 25 November 1974.

Where representations are made against the nomination of a product, the Tariff and Development Board will conduct inquiries and will notify the dates on which submissions are required and the form in which they should be lodged. In those cases where the inquiries result in a decision to include the goods in Schedule A, and where the Australian Government is in agreement, such inclusion will be effected at the earliest practicable date following receipt of the report of the Tariff and Development Board.

Products on which no representations against inclusion in Schedule A have been received by the Board by 25 November 1974 will be added to the Schedule on 1 January 1975, provided the Australian Government agrees.

In some cases, it may be agreed between the Australian and New Zealand Governments to attach special conditions to the inclusion of a product in Schedule A.

(3) If any member dies, or resigns his office by writing under his hand addressed to the board or the Chairman or the Secretary thereof, or is absent without leave from the meetings of the Board for 3 consecutive meetings, or while holding office becomes for any reason ineligible to remain a member, the casual vacancy so created shall be filled as soon as practicable thereafter by the appointment of a member in the manner in which the vacating member was appointed, and the member appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the residue of the term of office of the member whom he replaces.

(4) Unless he sooner vacates his office every appointed member of the board shall continue in office until his successor comes into office.

## APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

3. This order applies with respect to all Swaziland oranges sold by way of retail in New Zealand.

## MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF SWAZILAND ORANGES

4. (1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for Swaziland oranges to which this order applies shall be:

(a) When sold by a retailer carrying on business in any of the metropolitan areas of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, or Dunedin, or in any of the Cities or Boroughs of Whangarei, Takapuna, Hamilton, Tauranga, Rotorua, Gisborne, New Plymouth, Stratford, Hawera, Wanganui, Palmerston North, Napier, Hastings, Masterton, Blenheim, Nelson, Greymouth, Timaru, Westport, Oamaru, Balclutha, Gore, or Invercargill—

24 cents per lb.

(b) When sold by a retailer carrying on business elsewhere—

1 lb, 25 cents;  
2 lb, 49 cents;  
3 lb, 74 cents;  
4 lb, 98 cents;  
5 lb, \$1.23;  
6 lb, \$1.47.

Fractions of a pound shall be calculated at the rate of 25 cents per pound. Quantities in excess of 6 lb shall be calculated at the rate of 24½ cents per pound.

(2) If in respect of any lot of oranges sold by a retailer the maximum price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of cents, the maximum price of the lot may be computed to the nearest whole cent.

## PROVISIONS FOR SPECIAL PRICES

5. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect of any Swaziland oranges to which this order applies where special circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary

charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of oranges, or may relate generally to all Swaziland oranges to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

**DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS**

6. Every retailer who offers or exposes any Swaziland oranges for sale in any shop shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the oranges to which it relates as to be obviously descriptive thereof, a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the following particulars:

(a) The retail price per pound of the oranges. Retailers to whom clause 4 (1) (b) of this order applies shall state at least the prices for 1 lb and 2 lb lots.
