WHEREAS the General Assembly of New Zealand stands prorogued to the 27th day of March 1975:

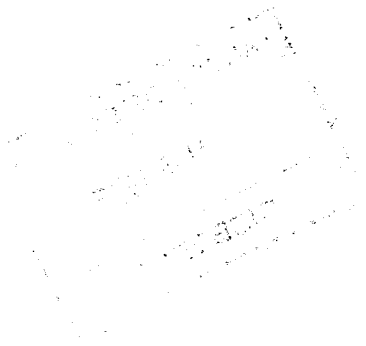
