The Honourable Michael Aynsley Connelly to be Minister of Works and Development

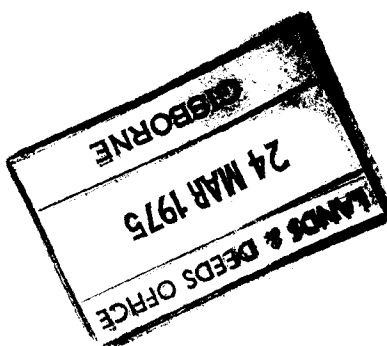
