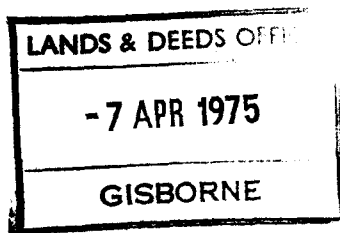
A PROCLAMATION

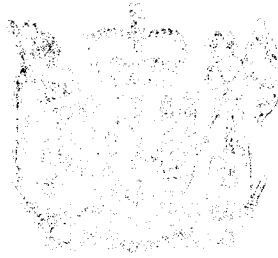
