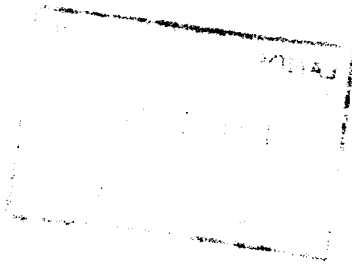

Notice: The Great Seal of the United States is a symbol of the nation's unity and independence.

The Great Seal of the United States is a symbol of the nation's unity and independence. It is a shield with thirteen stars and stripes, representing the original colonies. The shield is surrounded by a wreath of olive and arrows, symbolizing peace and war. Above the shield is a constellation of stars, representing the thirteen original colonies. The shield is held by an eagle, symbolizing strength and freedom. The Great Seal is used on the nation's official documents and is a symbol of the nation's unity and independence.
