A PROCLAMATION

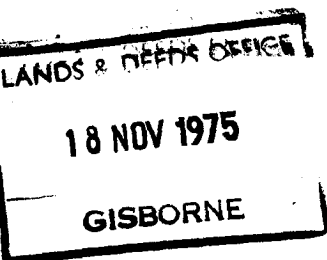

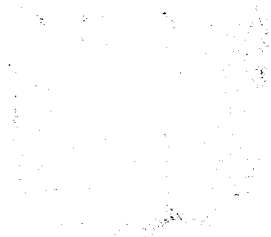
