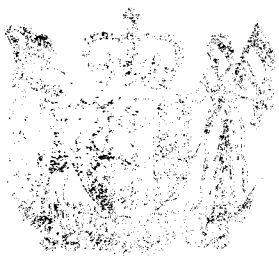
His Excellency the Governor-General has been pleased to constitute and appoint:
