State Forest Land Set Apart as State Forest Park

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 63A (1) (a) of the Forests Act 1949, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby set apart the State forest land described in the First Schedule hereto and further described in the Second Schedule hereto as a State forest park, to be known as Ruahine State Forest Park.

FIRST SCHEDULE

HAWKE'S BAY AND WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICTS—WELLINGTON CONSERVANCY—HAWKE'S BAY, RANGITIKEI, KIWITEA, WAI-PAWA, POHANGINA, DANNEVIRKE AND WOODVILLE COUNTIES

FIRSTLY, all that area in the Wellington and Hawke's Bay Land Districts containing 90076 hectares, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at Trig. Station 60A (Wharite) at the southernmost corner of Section 5, Block XV, Pohangina S.D., and proceeding generally north-easterly along the eastern boundaries of Sections 5, 2A, and 3A, Block XV, Pohangina S.D., the southern and north-western boundaries of Section 4, Block XV, Pohangina S.D. (including a right line across a road), the north-eastern boundary of Section 1, Block XV, Pohangina S.D., the end of No. 2 Line, the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 3 and 4, D.P. 1062, and Section 4, Block XI, Pohangina S.D., the south-western boundary of Section 9, Block XI, Pohangina S.D. (part of which is shown on D.P. 5341), the south-eastern boundary of the said Section 9, the end of Opawe Road, the south-eastern boundary of Section 10, Block XI, Pohangina S.D., the south-eastern boundary of Section 3, Block VII, Pohangina S.D., a right line to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, Plan A/1900, and Section 1, Block VIII, Pohangina S.D., a right line to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Section 3, Block VIII, Pohangina S.D., and Run 47, a right line to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Lot 2, D.P. 14436, and Sections 22 and 21, Block IV, Pohangina S.D., the south-western and generally south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 21, the end of and the eastern side of Takapari Road, and the eastern boundaries of Section 11, Block IV, Pohangina S.D., and Section 1, Block X, Umutoi S.D., to a point in line with the south-western boundary (bearing $113^{\circ} 58'$) of Section 25, Block X, Umutoi S.D.; thence generally easterly along a right line to and along that boundary and its production to the left bank of the Pohangina River, along that bank to a point due south-west of the south-western corner

of the reserved land along the right bank of the Pohangina River adjoining Section 27, Block X, Umutoi S.D., along a right line to that corner and along the southern boundaries of the said reserved land and Section 27 to and along the end of a road to the eastern side of the said road; thence generally northerly along the eastern and northern sides of the said road, the south-eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Section 32, Block X, Umutoi S.D., the south-eastern boundary of Lot 1, Plan A/2725, the south-eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 805, the eastern and southern sides of a road to a point in line with the western boundary of Section 3, Block VIII, Umutoi S.D., to and along that boundary, the western and northern boundaries of Section 2, Block VIII, Umutoi S.D. (including a right line across a road), the western and northern boundaries of Section 5, Block VIII, Umutoi S.D., the northern boundary of Section 28, Block IV, Umutoi S.D., the north-eastern boundary of Section 27, Block IV, Umutoi S.D., the eastern boundary of Section 26, Block IV, Umutoi S.D., and its production to the right bank of the Oroua River, along that bank, the end of a road, the southern, western, and northern boundaries of Section 46, Block IV, Umutoi S.D., the eastern boundary of Section 6, Block IV, Umutoi S.D., the end of Crown Road, the eastern boundary of the said Section 6 and its production to the southern boundary of Section 27, Block I, Umutoi S.D., along that boundary, the southern, western, and northern boundaries of Section 26, Block I, Umutoi S.D. (including a right line across a road), the western and northern boundaries of Section 21, Block I, Umutoi S.D., the northern boundary of Section 22, Block I, Umutoi S.D., to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Section 17, Block I, Umutoi S.D., to and along the eastern and northern boundaries of the said Section 17, the western boundaries of Sections 26 and 25, Block XIII, Ruahine S.D., the northern boundaries of the said Sections 25 and 26, the production of the last mentioned boundary to the right bank of the Pari Stream, along that bank to and along the left bank of the Pourangaki River to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of Section 2, Block X, Ruahine S.D., to and along that boundary, the south-western, western, and northern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 19106, the end of the road along the left bank of the Hikurangi River, along the left bank of the said river to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 2 of Section 3, Block X, Ruahine S.D., along a right line (approximately 40 metres) to the south-eastern corner of the said Lot 2, along the southern and western boundaries of the said Lot 2, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the right bank of Rocky Creek, along that bank to and along the left bank of the Kawhatau River to a point in line with the eastern

boundary of Section 5, Block VI, Ruahine S.D., to and along that boundary, the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 2 and 1 of Section 2, Block II, Ruahine S.D., the southern boundary of Section 6, Block II, Ruahine S.D., the end of Mokai Horse Track, the southern and eastern boundaries of Section 5, Block II, Ruahine S.D., the eastern boundaries of Sections 11 and 1, Block XIV, Pukeokahu S.D., the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 1 and 7, Block XIV, Pukeokahu S.D., and the left bank of the Rangitikei River to the south-western corner of Aorangi 1DB2; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of Aorangi 1DB2 and 1DB1 to the Wellington and Hawke's Bay District boundary; thence southerly along that boundary to the summit of the Ruahine Range; thence generally north-easterly along that summit passing through Trig. Stations S Piopio and 81 Ohawai to Trig. Station F Lessong Monument; thence along the southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 4425, to the south-western side of a public road; thence south-easterly and north-easterly along the south-western and south-eastern sides of that public road to the south-western boundary of Block 97, Maraekakaho Crown Grant District; thence south-easterly and north-easterly along the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of Block 97 aforesaid to Trig. Station Desolation, including the right line crossing of a public road; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of Lot 1, Deeds Plan 481, to the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 2559; thence south-westerly along that boundary to the northern boundary of Section 1, Block XI, Ngaruroro S.D., including the right line crossing of a public road; thence westerly, southerly, and easterly along the northern, western, and southern boundaries of the said Section 1 to the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 2559; thence southerly along that boundary and its production to and along the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 2560, to the northern boundary of Section 2, Block XI, Ngaruroro S.D.; thence westerly, southerly, and easterly along the northern, western, and southern boundaries of the said Section 2 to the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 2560; thence southerly along that boundary and its production to the northern boundary of Section 8, Block XV, Ngaruroro S.D.; thence generally south-westerly along the western boundaries of Sections 8, 15, 9, 10, 24, 26, and 29, Block XV, Ngaruroro S.D., part Section 1, Block II, Wakarara S.D., the western side of Mangletton Road, the western boundary of part Section 1 aforesaid, the western side of Mangletton Road, and again along the western boundary of part Section 1 aforesaid to the western boundary of Block 94, Wakarara Crown Grant District; thence southerly along that boundary to the left bank of the Makaroro River; thence westerly along the left bank of the Makaroro River to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 9, Block IX, Wakarara S.D.; thence south-westerly to and along the north-western boundary of Section 9, along a right line to and along the north-western boundaries of Sections 10, 11, and 12, Block IX, Wakarara S.D., Sections 10, 11, and 12, Block XIII, Wakarara S.D., and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the left bank of the Waipawa River; thence westerly along the left bank of that river to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 18, Block XIII, Wakarara S.D.; thence south-westerly to and along that boundary and along a right line to and along the north-western boundary of Section 23, Block XIII, Wakarara S.D., and its production to the right bank of the Middle Stream; thence easterly along that right bank to the easternmost corner of Section 5, Block V, Makaretu S.D.; thence southerly and south-westerly along the eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Section 5 aforesaid to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Section 6, Block V, Makaretu S.D.; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to the north-western boundary of Section 1, Block V, Makaretu S.D.; thence south-westerly along that boundary to Alder Road, along a right line to and along the north-western boundary of Section 2, Block V, Makaretu S.D., and its production to the left bank of the Tukituki River; thence south-westerly along the left bank of that river to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Section 2, Block VII, Makaretu S.D.; thence generally south-easterly to and along that boundary, the south-western boundary of Section 4, Block VII, Makaretu S.D., and the western and southern boundaries of Section 1, Block VIII, Makaretu S.D., to the abutment of Kashmir Road; thence southerly along that abutment to and easterly along the southern side of Kashmir Road to the north-western boundary of Section 6, Block II, Makaretu S.D.; thence south-westerly along that boundary to the northern boundary of Section 2, Block VIII, Makaretu S.D.; thence westerly, southerly, and easterly along the northern, western, and southern boundaries of section 2 aforesaid to the north-western boundary of Section 1, Block III, Makaretu S.D.; thence south-westerly along that boundary, the abutment of a public road, the north-western boundary of Section 3, Block III, Makaretu S.D., and the north-western

boundary of Lots 1 and 2 of Section 154, Block IV, Makaretu S.D., to the left bank of the Makaretu River; thence westerly along that left bank to a point in line with the left bank of a tributary of the Makaretu River forming the northern boundary of Lot 7, D.P. 2363, and to and along that left bank to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Lot 7, D.P. 2363; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to the northern boundary of part Section 5, Block II, Norsewood S.D.; thence south-easterly, southerly and south-westerly along the north-eastern, eastern and south-eastern boundaries of part Section 5 aforesaid to the north-eastern side of a public road; thence south-westerly along a right line to and along the south-eastern, south-western and south-eastern boundaries of Section 4, Block II, Norsewood S.D., to the north-eastern boundary of Te Ohu Block; thence north-westerly along that boundary to the summit of the Ruahine Range; thence southerly along that summit to the south-western boundary of Te Ohu Block; thence south-easterly along that boundary to the south-eastern boundary of Piripiri Block; thence generally south-westerly along that boundary, the south-eastern boundaries of Umutaoroa Block, Section 1, Block VII, Norsewood S.D., part Tamaki No. 1 Block, Section 1, Block XI, Norsewood S.D., and the south-eastern boundary of part Maharahara Block to the south-western corner of Section 4, Block XV, Woodville S.D.; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 2765, and north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of Section 6, Block VII, Gorge S.D., to the point of commencement; excluding therefrom Section 23, Block I, Umutoi S.D., Awarua 1A3B, situated in Block XIV, Ruahine S.D., all public roads, and all lands reserved along the banks of rivers and streams.

Secondly, all those areas in the Wellington Land District containing together 183,1202 hectares, more or less, being Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, Block VII, Gorge S.D.

DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL

All the books consist solely of photographs of young boys (pre-puberty upwards), mostly naked but some partly clothed. In general they consist of highly contrived and artificial poses, and clearly come within the third category of the 1968 *Waverley* decisions (93-103). The claim made by the distributor that several of them fall within the general category of naturist magazines is quite untenable. In the case of *Boys International*, some previous issues were the subject of decisions No. 618-20 (*N.Z. Gazette*, 15 March 1973, p. 486); that decision makes clear that the publication then included written material as well as photographs, and that the latter were naturally posed. Neither of these statements applies to the issues now before the Tribunal.

The Tribunal classifies these 10 publications as indecent. 16 December 1975.

Public Hearing

1. Following receipt by the then Minister of Trade and Industry of a report from the Emergency Protection Authority concerning temporary protection from the New Zealand industry producing certain woven polyester and warp knitted curtain and dress net fabrics, the Minister notified the Tariff and Development Board in a letter dated 3 April 1975 that the Authority had concluded that urgent action was necessary to protect the local industry and that the most suitable means of providing this protection was by way of import licensing. Government had accepted the Authority's recommendation and the exemption from import licensing for the following had been withdrawn:

For the purpose of taking evidence the Commission will hold a public hearing in the Hearing Room, Eighth Floor, Cumberland House, Upper Willis Street, Wellington, commencing on 27 April 1976 at 10.30 a.m. A consolidated list of all the goods under inquiry together with current rates of duty is appended in the Schedule to this notice.

4. Any person who intends to tender evidence should lodge, in typewritten form, 12 copies of public evidence and 10 copies of confidential evidence, to be presented under oath at the public hearing, at the Commission's office no later than 19 March 1976.
