of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister

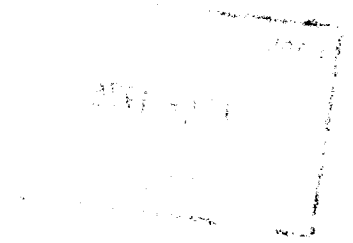
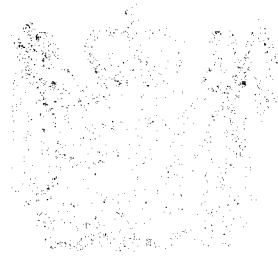
