*Transfer of Refuse Disposal Function to the Auckland Regional Authority*

PURSUANT to the Local Government Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order shall come into force on 1 May 1976.

2. The functions of every constituent authority within the Auckland Regional District in relation to the disposal of refuse (in this order referred to as "the function") shall be transferred to the Auckland Regional Authority (in this order referred to as "the Authority").

3. Nothing in this order shall authorise the Authority to collect any refuse from any place or to transport any refuse to any place except as may be necessary for the ultimate disposal of refuse deposited at facilities provided by the Authority for refuse of that kind.

4. After this order comes into force, the Authority shall, by special order, appoint a date on which the function shall be transferred from each constituent authority to the Authority, being a date not earlier than 6 months after the making of that special order; and the provisions of subsection (2) of section 73 of the Local Government Act 1974, shall not apply to such transfer:

Provided that the function may, by agreement between the Authority and any constituent authority, be undertaken by that constituent authority to the extent and in the manner so agreed.

Provided, further, that in appointing the date of such transfer, the Authority shall have regard to any representations made by or on behalf of that constituent authority.

5. The provisions of subsections (2), (3), (4), (5), and (6) of section 96 of the Local Government Act 1974, shall apply in respect of such transfer as if the Authority undertakes the function by agreement with each constituent authority, and as if for the purposes of subsection (3) of the said section 96, the date of the transfer is a term under which the transfer is to be effected.

6. The function shall be deemed to be a public work for the purpose of the Public Works Act 1928.

7. The functions and powers conferred on the Authority, pursuant to this order, shall be in addition to any other functions and powers of the Authority.

(iii) The annual water availability charge shall be \$160 per litre per second flow available to each property.

(iv) The basic charge and water availability charge shall be reduced during the first 6 seasons of supply to those charges set out in the Schedule hereto.

(v) The charges have been based on the estimated development and maintenance costs of the proposed scheme, and shall be subject to annual adjustment from the end of the seventh season of supply to compensate for any difference in any element of these charges from the amount previously estimated, under sections 13 and 15 of the Act, and as stated above.

(vi) The object of the scheme is to provide a reliable water supply for irrigation of land within the proposed district by a piped water supply from the Okuku River to a storage reservoir, and from this point it will be either reticulated to a holding tank on the property or supplied through a restrictor valve to the property, as appropriate, to enable trickle-irrigation of established and proposed orchards, as well as limited areas of other horticultural crops.

(vii) It is estimated that the scheme is capable of providing a reliable water supply for all of the proposed district.

(viii) Supply of water is subject to the terms of the Water Right Number NCY 730544, issued by the North Canterbury Regional scheme. This right provides for the continuous removal of 4582 cubic metres per day at a rate not exceeding 53 litres per second from the Okuku River. The right is subject to the condition that the taking of water is to be rostered by all grantees to maintain a flow of at least 160 litres per second in the Ashley River at the No. 1 State Highway bridge. (A drought requiring this type of rostering is envisaged about once in 10 years on average). The water right allows an average supply of 2.25 litres per tree, continuously every hour, and on an assessed tree density of 333 trees per hectare for all the defined irrigable area, provided the water supply permits the exercising of the full right granted.

(ix) The proposed scheme is to be constructed as a whole and can be brought into full operation during the 1976-77 season.

(x) The Minister requires not less than 60% of valid votes cast in the poll, to be held under Part XI of the Public Works Act 1928, to be in favour of the proposed irrigation scheme as a prerequisite to its construction.

(xi) The minimum aggregate area of land occupied by any occupier that it is proposed to include in the proposed irrigation scheme shall be one hectare.

#### DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL

Five issues of this magazine have now been before the Tribunal (Decisions 745-747, 799, and 832). In decisions 745-747 the Tribunal noted; "The interest in contemporary affairs is very limited and light-weight. The dominant concern in the cartoons, text . . . and the illustrations, is with presenting sex for entertainment and amusement. The explicitness of some of this material, and the indulgent tone with which extreme and perverted manifestations of sexual interest are allowed for, make these issues clearly unsuitable for younger readers and marginal for adults."

In considering subsequent issues, the Tribunal has been aware of a trend toward greater emphasis upon the sexual content of the magazine.

While this issue continues the trend, it also reveals a subtle change in tone over previous issues. Indulgence has given way to prurience. Three articles in particular, contribute to this view. They are "Sex Tapes" (which constitutes a forum for readers to relate their sexual excesses), an article on telephone masturbation and sex fantasia services and a sequence of photographic illustrations depicting the seduction of a young girl by her aunt. These articles, together with other material dealing with the subject of sex, affect the overall tone of the magazine and, thus, its dominant effect is to debase and exploit sex. Those articles which are intended to be informative and serious remain light-weight and limited and, in the Tribunal's view, are included merely as camouflage to render acceptable indecent parts of the magazine. Thus, this issue of *Oui* fails to meet the criteria for our consideration under Section 11 of the Act.

The Tribunal classifies this magazine as indecent.
