*Notice to Make Returns of Income Under the Land and Income Tax Act 1954*

  - (b) Every person whose total income from employment exceeded \$2,600.
  - (c) Every person who derived income from employment, the whole or any part of which was not taxed at source.
  - (d) Every person who derived interest and/or investment or building society dividends and whose total income (after deducting interest exemptions) exceeded \$750.
  - (e) Every person who derived assessable income, other than income from employment, and whose total income exceeded \$750 except that no return is required where the total income did not exceed \$1,530 and consisted exclusively of dividends.
  - (f) Every person who paid provisional tax in respect of income for the year ended 31 March 1976.
  - (g) Every person who received withholding payments. Note, however, that a return is not required where a person does not come within any of the classes referred to in (a) to (f) above inclusive and the only withholding payments received were:
    - (i) Juror's or witness's fees, and/or
    - (ii) Not in excess of \$24 in the aggregate and consisting of one or more of the following classes: honoraria; fees for contributions to newspapers, journals, etc., or for radio or stage presentations; modelling or demonstrating goods or appliances; theatre, stage, concert, and radio performances; payments for election-day services.
  - (h) Every unincorporated body which derived assessable income.
  - (i) Every absentee who derived income from New Zealand.
- (2) Returns are required to be furnished by posting or delivering the same to the office of the Inland Revenue Department nearest to the place of residence of the taxpayer, or if the taxpayer's records are held in another office of the department, then to the latter office.

(3) Returns are due on:

- (a) 7 June 1976 when income was derived from salary, wages, superannuation (including Universal Superannuation), pensions, taxable allowances, etc., and
  - (i) No other income whatsoever was derived, or
  - (ii) The other income derived consisted exclusively of not more than \$200 in total from dividends, net rents, interest (after the interest exemptions).
- (b) 7 August 1976 in all other cases or within two months of balance date, whichever is the later. No action for failure to furnish a return due on 7 August 1976 will be taken if it is furnished by 7 September 1976.

The return to be used is IR 5 (green print) in the case of paragraph 3 (a) above, and the IR 3 (black print) in the case of 3 (b) above.

In addition to return IR 3, farmers are to complete supplementary return IR 3F and persons in business or in a profession are to complete supplementary return IR 3B. (The supplementary returns are not required if a copy of the annual accounts is furnished with the return). Companies are to use IR 4 and estates and trusts IR 5A. Each form indicates the classes of taxpayers, who are to use that form and, where applicable, the due dates for payment of provisional tax.

(4) Return forms and guides have been mailed to all taxpayers. Additional forms are available from Inland Revenue and post offices.

(5) Any person or company failing to furnish a return within the prescribed time is liable to a fine, not exceeding \$200 and not less than \$4.

(6) Any person who is not required under paragraph (1) to furnish a return and who has derived income from employ-

ment may elect to furnish a return using IR 5 if an adjustment is required because of:

- (a) Life insurance premiums paid.
- (b) Additional rebates or exemptions which were not included in the tax code during the year.
- (c) The standard deduction from salary/wages of \$50 (reduced to 2 percent of salary/wages if below \$2,500).

(7) Any person furnishing a return of income who derived income taxed at time of payment should securely attach all tax deduction certificates (IR 12, IR 13) to the return form.

### Decision of the Indecent Publications Tribunal

Ltd.; *New Apollo*, Issue 5, published by Herd Publishing Co. Pty. Ltd.; *Era*, Collectors Edition, published by Q.Q. Publishing Co. Ltd.; *Ribald*, Number 93, published by Bertram Horne Co. Pty. Ltd.; *Gay*, Number 9, newspaper, published by Bertram Horne Co. Pty. Ltd.

#### DECISION

This group of documents come before us on reference from the Magistrate's Court in proceedings for condemnation, under the Customs Act 1966, following disputed forfeiture by the Customs Department. We were told that the material was imported by a private importer in September 1974 for his own use and not for sale, he having purchased them from a book shop or book shops in Sydney. We were not given any explanation for the apparent delay since seizure in September 1974.

The documents are not all of the same kind and rather different considerations apply to some of them.

The magazines *New Apollo*, *Mankind*, *Body*, *Male International Nudes* and *Australian Golden Boys* consist entirely, or almost entirely, of photographs of young men naked and photographed so as to emphasise the penis.

*Era* consists almost entirely of naked and partly clothed young men. There is not the same emphasis on the penis in this book and it is said in the text that it is intended as a retrospective work republishing photographs of "famous models" whose photographs had appeared in other magazines from the days before "the frontal nude type of physique pictorial". All these magazines are clearly published to appeal to homosexuals.

*Stallion* and *CIAO* are both magazines which have a considerable amount of text but with some photographs, especially in the case of *CIAO*, similar to the first group mentioned above. Both magazines are frankly homosexual and applaud and appear to be intended to encourage homosexual associations.

*Gay* and *Ribald* look like newspapers published in Australia by the same company. Neither are dated and we conclude from internal evidence that they are occasional publications which come within the definition of magazines. The first of these is homosexual, the latter is heterosexual. Both contain photographs, cartoons, and advertisements which are clearly indecent in themselves.

In submissions to us Mr Neville urged us to take into consideration (*inter alia*) a number of publications and extracts from publications which, it was alleged, were available for purchase in New Zealand in September 1974 or later. One of these, *Australian Golden Boys* Vol. 1, No. 1, was classified indecent in Decision 722 (*New Zealand Gazette* No. 80, 23 August, p. 1618). None of the others had come before us previously at least in the form presented to us at this hearing.

In all the circumstances, we believe that such material is not relevant to our consideration of the documents now before us.

We have given careful consideration to the submissions made to us and to the matters referred to in section 11 of the Act. The photographic material, the text, advertisements, and cartoons in each of the documents lead us to conclude that the dominant effect of each is objectionable and injurious to the public good. Although this is not a case of intended distribution for gain, the documents readily lend themselves to improper and harmful use.

In conclusion, we should record some sympathy for the importer who after 18 months finds himself a private importer of indecent documents, but this is not a matter which can affect our decision.

The Tribunal classifies each document as indecent.

#### DECISION

These four publications submitted by Seven Seas Publishing Pty. Limited are from different sources, two being German in origin, the others from San Francisco. What they appear



to have in common is a claim to be serious and acceptable treatments of various sexual matters. In our view these claims fail against the tests we are required to use in accordance with section 11 of the Act.

For example, two from the same stable (the respectable-sounding Multi Media Resource Centre, San Francisco) claim on their front covers to be "educational material for adults" and on its back cover *The Yes Book of Sex: You Can Last Longer* states that it is "for use by persons in the helping professions, in counselling, in therapy and education, and for people who want to make it last longer". Inside are 45 pages, of which about one-quarter is text, the remainder consisting of coloured photographs in intimate detail of sexual intercourse. Whatever real value there might be in the text is lost in the plethora of close-up photographs. These so dominate the book that its seriousness of intent is called in question by the lack of balance. The same consideration applies to the other *Yes Book of Sex*.

One of the books of German origin is translated into English in the edition before the Tribunal. This is the *Full Color Guide to Sexual Pleasures from A to Z* by Günther Hunold. It is arranged in alphabetic form with entries up to 200 words, lavishly illustrated with colour photographs. It is very different in tone and treatment from books such as *The XYZ of Love* (Decision No. 286) (*New Zealand Gazette* No. 38, 27 May 1971, p. 997), and *The Joy of Sex* (Decision No. 848) (*New Zealand Gazette* No. 98, 6 November 1975, p. 2455) to which the Tribunal has given restricted classifications, and it cannot make claims on grounds of literary or artistic merit, or social or scientific character, which would lead us to regard it as other than indecent.

The other German book, *Lustreiche Stellungen* is in a German edition, and is evidently the first of a series under the title *Sexualität Heute* (Sexuality today). Its principal contents are again a series of coloured photographs of sexual intercourse in various positions, with some supporting text. The highly posed character of many of the photographs, and the general imbalance between text and illustration, again lead us to find it indecent.

We therefore find all four publications to be indecent.
