ALL that area in the counties of Southland, Clutha, and Tuapeka; Southland and Otago Land Districts, containing an estimated area of 448 264 hectares, more or less, inclusive of roads, railways, and streams, bounded by a line commencing at the confluence of the new channels of the Hedgehope Stream and Makarewa River, constructed by the Southland Catchment Board in 1966 and 1967, and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the left bank of the new course of the Makarewa River to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 193, Block V, Forest Hill Hundred; thence generally easterly across a public road and along the southern boundaries of Sections 193 and 194, Block V, Forest Hill Hundred, to the northernmost corner of Section 323, Block V, aforesaid; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the north-western and south-western boundaries of the said Section 323 to the north-western side of a public road forming the south-eastern boundaries of the said Section 323; thence north-easterly along the north-western side of the said public road to the south-western corner of Block IX, Forest Hill Hundred; thence generally easterly and northerly along the southern and eastern boundaries of Block IX, aforesaid, to the southern boundary of Section 133, Block X, Forest Hill Hundred; thence easterly along the southern boundary of Section 133, Block X, aforesaid to the south-eastern corner thereof; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Section 133, Block X, aforesaid, and that boundary, produced to the northern boundary of Block X, aforesaid; thence westerly along the northern boundary of Block X, aforesaid, to the eastern boundary of Section 429, Block XI, Forest Hill Hundred; thence northerly along the eastern boundaries of Sections 429, 428, 427, 426, 425, and 421, Block XI, aforesaid, to the eastern side of a public road forming the eastern boundary of Section 422, Block XI, aforesaid; thence generally northerly along the eastern side of the said public road to the eastern boundary of Section 419, Block XI, aforesaid; thence northerly along the eastern boundaries of Sections 419 and 465, Block XI, aforesaid, Section 460, Block XVII, Forest Hill Hundred, across a public road and again northerly along the eastern boundary of Section 455, Block XVII, aforesaid, to the southern boundary of the Hokonui Survey District; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the Hokonui Survey District; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the Hokonui Survey District to the eastern boundary of Block LXIII, Hokonui Survey District; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Block LXIII, aforesaid, to the southern boundary of Section 1004, Block XLVII, Hokonui Survey District; thence easterly along the southern boundaries of Sections 1004 and 448, Block XLVII, aforesaid, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the right bank of the Otamita Stream; thence northerly and westerly along the right bank of the Otamita Stream to the eastern boundary of Run 550, Block

XLVI, Hokonui Survey District; thence generally north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Run 550 to the south-eastern corner of Section 985, Block XXXVIII, Hokonui Survey District; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of the said Section 985 and the south-western boundaries of Part Sections 1058 and 971, Block XXVI, Hokonui Survey District, to the south-western corner of part Section 971, aforesaid; thence northerly along the western boundary of the said part Section 971 to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 484, Block XXXV, Hokonui Survey District; thence westerly, northerly, and north-westerly along the southern, western, and south-western boundaries of the said Section 484 to the north-western side of a public road passing through the said section; thence generally south-easterly to and along the south-western boundary of that run and Section 4, Block I, Wart Hill Survey District, and its production to the eastern side of the Heriot-Roxburgh via Moa Flat Road; thence southerly along the eastern side of that road to its intersection with the northern side of Moa Flat School Road in Block VI, Bengier Survey District; thence generally easterly and south-easterly along the northern and north-eastern sides of that road to the north-western corner of Lot 9, D.P. 1924; thence generally easterly and south-easterly along the northern boundary of that lot and the northern and north-eastern boundaries of Lot 8, D.P. 1924, to the easternmost corner of the last-mentioned lot; thence generally south-easterly, along the south-western boundaries of part Lot 6, D.P. 1864, and Sections 9 and 10, Block XVII, Crookston Survey District, to a point in line with the northwestern boundary of Section 11, Block XVII, aforesaid; thence south-westerly to and along the western boundary of that section, and the western boundaries of Sections 23 and 12, and westerly along the northern boundaries of Section 13, to the north-western corner of the said Section 13; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of Section 14 and Block XIII to the north-western corner of Section 11, Block XVI; thence easterly, southerly, and generally westerly along the northern, eastern, and southern boundaries of that section to the south-western corner of the said Section 11; thence southerly to and along the western boundary of Run 708 to the northern side of an unnamed road; thence north-easterly for a distance of 80 metres to the north-western side of an unsurveyed road passing through Run 708, aforesaid and State forest; *The Aerial Work Services Standard Terms and Conditions Order 1976*

WHEREAS by section 26A of the Air Services Licensing Act 1951, the Air Services Licensing Authority has made an order prescribing terms and conditions applicable to licences to carry on classes of aerial work services specified in the order.

And whereas it is provided in subsection (9) of the said section 26A that every such order of the Air Services Licensing Authority shall be published in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

Now, therefore, the Air Services Licensing Authority, pursuant to section 26A of the said Act and any other powers in that Act in that behalf enabling hereby, notifies that order.

**ORDER**

1. This order may be cited as the Aerial Work Services Standard Terms and Conditions Order 1976.

2. The order prescribing standard terms and conditions for aerial work services, dated 31 October 1972, and amendments thereto\* are hereby revoked.

3. Unless otherwise ordered by the licensing authority, in respect of a particular licence, the following terms and conditions shall apply to the extent indicated to licences to carry on aerial work services of the classes specified:

**(a) Aerial Topping Service by Fixed-Wing Aircraft:**

In each licence to carry on such a service the licensing authority shall specify the maximum fleet payload which may be used for Category I Aircraft and/or the maximum fleet payload which may be used for Category II aircraft. The licensee may use any number of fixed-wing aircraft of the appropriate category but the aggregate payload of the aircraft within the category shall not exceed the specified maximum fleet payload for the category.

**(b) Aerial Topping Service and Miscellaneous Aerial Work Service by Rotary-Wing Aircraft; Aerial Liquid Topping Service and Aerial Spraying Service by Fixed-Wing and Rotary-Wing Aircraft:**

In each licence to carry on any such service the licensee may use such number (but no more than the number) and such types or categories of aircraft as are specified in the licence for the particular service.

**(c) Replacement of Aircraft:**

(i) The holder of a licence to carry on an aerial topping service with fixed-wing aircraft, in which a maximum fleet payload is specified, may replace any aircraft of a specified category used in such a service with another aircraft of that specified category, provided that the aggregate payloads of the aircraft thereafter used in that category shall

not exceed the specified maximum fleet payload for the category.

(ii) The holder of a licence to carry on an aerial liquid topdressing service, or an aerial spraying service with fixed-wing aircraft, may replace any aircraft of a specified category used in such a service with another aircraft of that specified category.

(iii) The holder of a licence to carry on an aerial work service may replace any rotary-wing aircraft with another rotary-wing aircraft of substantially the same capacity. Provided that, in cases of replacement of rotary-wing aircraft with a different type, written notice shall be given to the licensing authority within 7 days of such replacement being effected.

4. Unless otherwise ordered by the licensing authority, in respect of a particular licence, it shall be a condition of all licences to carry on aerial work services that:

**(1) Boundaries:**

- (a) Where any boundary of the areas authorised in a licence for an aerial work service passes through any part of a farming property, the licensee may enter into an agreement with the owner or occupier of such property for the carrying out of any aerial work service authorised by the licence on the whole or any part of that property, provided that a substantial part thereof is within the licensee's authorised area.
- (b) Where in any licence for the carrying on of aerial work services a boundary is defined, *inter alia*, as being a line running from the mouth of a river or other waterway, such line shall be deemed to run from the northern side of the mouth of such river or other waterway unless the licence otherwise provides.
- (c) Any zone of limitation of area of operation which the authority shall impose on an aerial topdressing service shall not apply to the release from aircraft during flight of any bait or animal poison for the purpose of destroying or repelling noxious animals.

**(2) Insurance:**

- (a) The licence holder shall maintain during the currency of the licence in respect of all aircraft, insurance against liability to pay damages on account of property damage. The insurance cover shall be for a minimum of \$250,000 for any claim by or in respect of any person for property damage arising from each accident or incident.
- (b) Notwithstanding that the licence may authorise the carrying on of an aerial work service as from a specific date, such service shall not be commenced until there has been deposited with the licensing authority a certificate endorsed by the insurers of due insurance in accordance with the requirements in paragraph (a) herein.
- (c) Not later than 4 p.m. on the due date for renewal of any such insurance there shall be deposited with the licensing authority a certificate endorsed by the insurers, of the due renewal or replacement of the insurance in accordance with the requirements in paragraph (a) herein.

**(3) Transfer of Interest in Licences:**

**(a) Where:**

(i) The licensee is an individual and by any means whatsoever his controlling interest in the business to which the licence applies is to pass to any other person or persons; or

(ii) The licensee is a company and by any means whatsoever the controlling interest in that company is to pass to any person or persons other than those named as shareholders or intending shareholders when the application for a licence was made

the licensee must notify the licensing authority of the proposed transaction and obtain its approval.

- (b) Where by reason of transmission on death the provisions of paragraph (a) (i) herein would apply, the executor or administrator or trustee of a deceased holder of the Licence in respect of which the business applies shall notify the licensing authority within 3 months of the death of the said licensee.

This order shall come into effect on the 21st day of October 1976.
