Pursuant to the Commerce Act 1975, I, Peter Edward Donovan, pursuant to a delegation from the Secretary of Trade and Industry, hereby make the following price order:

- 1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 47 and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 28* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
 - 2. This order shall come into force on the 5th day of February 1977.
 - 3. The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto, and substituting the following Schedule.
