ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this fifth day of September 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 8A and 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (a) This order may be cited as the Port Waikato Order 1977.

(b) This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. In this order—

"The Act" means the Harbours Act 1950:

"The Council" means the Raglan County Council:

"Foreshore" means such parts of the bed, shore, or banks of a tidal water as are covered and uncovered by the ebb and flow of the tide at ordinary spring tides:

"Minister" means the Minister of Transport; and includes any officer, person or authority acting by or under the direction or authority of the Minister.

3. There is hereby granted to the Council for a period of 21 years from the commencement of this order, the control of foreshore and waters described in the First Schedule to this order, subject to the provisions of sections 8A and 165 of the Act, and to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

4. The Port Waikato Order 1971* is hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF FORESHORE AND WATERS

ALL the foreshore and waters of the Tasman Sea and the Waikato River, bounded by a line commencing at high-water mark at a point in line with the extension of the western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. S. 4761, thence due north into the Tasman Sea for a distance of 200 metres, thence generally northerly, at a distance of 200 metres from high-water mark to a point due north of the extremity of the southern spit at the mouth of the Waikato River, thence by a right line bearing 045° true to the opposite bank of the Waikato River, and then generally easterly by the line of low-water mark to a point bearing 315° from the most northerly point of section 5 40422L, and thence by a right line in a 135° direction to high water mark on the opposite bank of the Waikato River, and thence generally westerly along the line of high water mark to the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS

1. Her Majesty or the Governor-General and all officers in the government service acting in the execution of their duty shall, at all times, have free ingress, passage and egress into, over, and out of the foreshore and waters described in the First Schedule to this Order.

2. Nothing in this order shall authorise the Council to do or cause to be done anything repugnant to or inconsistent with any law relating to the Customs or any provisions of the Harbours Act 1950 that is, or may hereafter be, in force.

3. The rights, powers, and privileges conferred by this Order in Council shall not apply to those portions of the foreshore required for securing the shore ends of any telegraph cables that are at present, or may be at any time, laid down within the area of foreshore described in the First Schedule to this Order.

4. The Council may enclose any part or parts of the foreshore, described in the First Schedule to this Order, for the purpose of holding sports meetings or games, and may, by bylaws, fix a charge for admission to any such enclosed part or parts: provided that the total number of days on which any particular part of that foreshore is so enclosed shall not exceed 6 in any one calendar year.

5. Nothing in this order shall authorise the Council to remove or cause to be removed from the foreshore described in the First Schedule to this order any stone, sand, shingle, or shells without the consent in writing of the Minister being first obtained.

6. Subject to the provisions of section 8A of the Act, the Council for and within the area of waters described in the First Schedule hereto:

- May by bylaw do anything which a harbour board may do by bylaw under section 232 of the Act;
- May appoint harbourmasters and/or officers and define or limit their powers or duties;
- Shall have all the powers, functions, duties, and authorities of a harbour board, under the Act, as if it were constituted a harbour board.
- May expend money out of its general fund or account for the purpose of exercising and performing the control, power, functions, duties, and authorities conferred by this Order in Council.

7. Bylaws made by the Council under the authority of this Order in Council shall not come into force until they have been approved by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

8. The rights, powers, and privileges conferred on the Council by this Order may be at any time resumed by the Governor-General, without payment or any compensation whatever, on giving to the Council at least 6 months' notice in writing. Any such notice shall be sufficient if given by the Minister and delivered at or posted to the Council at its public office.

- (g) One member elected by associations of employees which are not represented by the member appointed by the Bay of Plenty District Trades Council or by the member elected by the associations specified in Third Schedule to this notice;
- (h) One member appointed jointly by the Rotorua Taupo Province Inc. and the Eastern Bay of Plenty Province Inc. of Federated Farmers of New Zealand;
- (i) One member elected by the associations listed in the Third Schedule to this notice;
- (j) One member appointed by the council of the University of Waikato;
- (k) One member appointed by the Waiariki District Maori Council;
- (l) One member, who shall be resident in the region served by the college, appointed by the National Council of Women in New Zealand Inc.;
- (m) One member who shall be the Principal of the Rotorua Community College;
- (n) One member who shall represent the staff of the Rotorua Community College, and who shall be elected by full-time teachers employed by the council, and who shall also be a full-time teacher employed by council;

Provided that the first election of the member shall take place as soon as practicable after the opening date of the community college, being the 1st day of April 1978;

Provided also that the member so elected shall hold office until the 15th day of November 1980, and if on that date the election of his successor has not been notified to the council, he shall continue to hold office until the date on which that election is notified;

- (o) (i) One member who shall represent the students of the Rotorua Community College, and who shall be elected to a term of office of one academic year by students of the college, and who shall also be a student of the college:

Provided that the first election of the member shall take place as soon as practicable after the opening date of the college, being the 1st day of April 1978;

(ii) Subject to subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, the election of the student representative for each academic year shall take place as soon as practicable after the commencement of each academic year;

(iii) The member elected pursuant to subparagraph (i) of this paragraph shall hold office until the 1st day of February in the year after the year of his election and, if on that date the election of his successor has not been notified to the council, he shall continue to hold office until the date on which that election is notified; and

(iv) For the purposes of subparagraph (i) of this paragraph a "student of the college" shall be defined as any student enrolled in a course of study at the Rotorua Community College at the time of the calling of nominations for the election of the student representative and the term "academic year" shall be defined as being the period from the 1st day of February in any one calendar year to the 31st day of January in the subsequent calendar year; and

- (p) Not more than three members to be co-opted by the council itself, if and when it thinks fit, of whom one member shall be co-opted to represent the interests of local educational, youth, and welfare organisations not otherwise represented, and of whom one member shall be co-opted to represent the interests of local cultural organisations not otherwise represented.

4. (1) Subject to the provisions of this clause and the provisions of paragraph (n) and subparagraph (i) of paragraph (o) of clause 3 of this notice, the members of the

Rotorua Community College Council shall hold office for a term of 3 years but may from time to time be reappointed or re-elected.

(2) Every co-opted member of the council shall be appointed for such terms not exceeding 3 years as the council thinks fit.
