(NOTE: This is equivalent to \$38.65/ha for an "average" irrigation season involving 4370 "units" of water spread over the 1550 hectares.)
- (iv) The basic charge and water availability charges shall be reduced during the first six seasons of supply to those charges set out in the Schedule hereto.
- (v) The charges have been based on the estimated development and maintenance costs of the proposed scheme, and shall be subject to annual adjustment from the end of the seventh season of supply to compensate for any difference in any element of these charges from the amount previously estimated, under sections 13 and 15 of the Act and as stated above.
- (vi) The object of the scheme is to provide a water supply for irrigation of land within the proposed district by gravity open race supply from the Ngaruroro River.
- (vii) The unit of water chosen is 1000 m³. The average irrigation requirement is approximately 3 times per season (with a range of 0-7). Allowing a 50 percent efficiency factor for water "losses" as normal, the average would require 4370 units of water spread over the 1550 hectares. This would be supplied as an average of 1550 units of water supplied at a rate of 800 m³ per roster hour. It is estimated that the supply of water to the proposed scheme may be subject to restriction in some years during periods of low flow in the river.
- (viii) The supply of water will be subject to conditions of the water right yet to be granted by the National Water and Soil Conservation Authority on the recommendation of the Hawke's Bay Regional Water Board.
- (ix) The proposed scheme is to be constructed as a whole and can be brought into full production during the year 1980-81, subject to appropriate financial allocations by Government.
- (x) The Minister requires not less than 60 percent of valid votes cast in the poll held under part VI of the Public Works Amendment Act 1975 to be in favour of the proposed irrigation scheme as a prerequisite to its construction.
- (xi) The minimum aggregate area of land occupied by any occupier that it is proposed to include in the proposed irrigation scheme shall be four hectares.

4. No assistant under 18 years of age shall be employed in or about the exhibition after the hour of 10.30 p.m.

5. For the purposes of the enforcement of any collective agreements or awards, any provision of which has been suspended by this order, any officer of the industrial union or association concerned who is authorised in writing in that behalf by the union or association shall be entitled to interview at his place of employment any person employed in or about the exhibition under those collective agreements or awards at such time or times as may be agreed upon between the officer and the employer of that person, and for this purpose any such officer shall be entitled at any time to have access to the register of passes issued by the promoter.

Decision No. 2/77

Decision of the Broadcasting Tribunal

IN the matter of the Broadcasting Act 1976, and in the matter of a complaint, pursuant to section 67 (1) (b) of the Act, between Clifford Reginald Turner and Arthur William Rushton Mead, complainants, and Broadcasting Corporation of New Zealand, respondent:

BEFORE THE BROADCASTING TRIBUNAL

Members: B. H. Slane (Chairman), Lionel R. Sceats, and Janet C. Somerville.

Co-opted members: S. H. Gardiner, and A. M. Perry.

Hearing at Wellington on the 26th day of September 1977.

DECISION

Mr C. R. Turner and Reverend A. W. R. Mead separately complained to the Broadcasting Corporation of New Zealand about the television commercial advertising the Lion Breweries “Man of the Test” promotion. They were dissatisfied with the corporation's rejection of their complaints.

It is not necessary to traverse in detail the complaints made to the Tribunal by each of the complainants except to say that one of them was unaware of the broadcasting rules made by the corporation and relied upon breaches of the Broadcasting Act.

The Tribunal does not consider that the advertisements were in breach of the statutory provision for the observance of good taste and decency (S. 24 (1) (c) Broadcasting Act 1976) or relating to the maintenance of law and order (S. 24 (1) (f)).

However, it is complained that the advertisement is in breach of the advertisement rules. The corporation itself restricts advertisements for alcoholic beverages by those rules which provide that:

“No station shall broadcast any advertisement which directly or by implication:

(q) Is designed to promote the general consumption of alcoholic beverages.

Advertisements for alcohol may be made only in accordance with the following conditions:

(1) Advertisements may be made only on behalf of a wholesale or retail point of sale, such as a vineyard, a wholesale store, a wine shop, or licensed premises.

(2) Advertisements must not use brand names as such. A brand name is one which is the name of a particular wine, spirit, or beer, etc., such as "Blue Nun", "Gordon's Gin", "Leopard Beer"; or one which refers to a range of wines, spirits, beers, etc., from a particular vintner, manufacturer or distributor, such as "Corbans" wines, "Lion" beers, "Gilbeys" spirits.

NOTE: There are some sale outlets which incorporate brand names in their title, e.g., "Corbans Wine Shop", "Montana Weinkeller", etc. These titles may be used in advertisements only in such a way that they refer clearly and consistently to the point of sale, and not to the brand of wine, etc.

(3) No descriptions of the qualities of any wine, beer or spirit, etc., are allowed in any advertisement.

(4) Advertisements must be confined to:

- (a) Details of the points of sale and the service, e.g., location, hours of sale, details of parking, delivery, and type of sale (wholesale or retail); and
- (b) Description of the general range of merchandise, e.g., "A full stock of New Zealand and overseas wines, New Zealand and imported spirits and cordials, and a wide range of beer in cans, bottles, and flacons."

The commercial complained of was, in fact, a series of commercials containing the same basic material updated as the tour of the British Isles team progressed through New Zealand.

The commercial opens and closes with a spoken reference to "Lion Breweries' Man of the Test".

The commercial opens with rugby scenes. It then shows a former All Black, Mr Waka Nathan, urging entry in the competition followed by a description of the prizes to be won. He says,

"Pick up your Lion Man of the Test entry form at your local Lion wholesale or bottlestores. And while you're there collect your beer, spirits, and party supplies".

The commercial ends with,

"Lion Breweries' Man of the Test. Enter now".

The Tribunal has noted that the rule says advertisements, directly or by implication, should not be designed to promote the general consumption of alcoholic beverages. There seems to be little doubt that the objective of the competition and the associated advertising was to promote the sale of Lion products.

An attempt is made to bring the advertisement within the rules by referring to wholesale and retail points of sale. However, it is clear from the graphic design of the advertisement that the Lion brand is promoted and this is clearly contrary to the corporation's rules.

The commercial shows bottles of beer and spirits which are clearly labelled and which may be identified by viewers by brand.

The exhortation,

"And while you're there collect your beer, spirits, and party supplies"

appears to the Tribunal to be a breach of the general rule of the corporation not to promote the general consumption of alcoholic beverages.

The Tribunal concludes that the commercial as produced should not have been accepted and broadcast.

NOTE: The co-opted members, Mrs A. M. Perry and S. H. Gardiner, took part in the deliberations of the Tribunal but the decision, in accordance with the Act, is that of the permanent members.

This report marks the culmination of the activities of the Educational Development Conference. The Advisory Council has recommended the directions it considers New Zealand education should go in the next 5 or 10 years.

Five principal areas are identified as requiring attention.

Education is seen as a lifelong activity, and emphasis is therefore placed on the "foundations"—early childhood education, the school curriculum and special provisions for special needs, and parent education.

Special attention is given also to the relationship between the school and the community, the need for close mutual support and co-operation, including understanding and respect for minority cultures.

A key to the quality of education is the people involved in it. Teacher education, the availability of advisory and ancillary staff, as well as resources for materials and research, have a chapter devoted to them.

Since education is seen as a lifelong activity, this is considered at some length. Facets such as accessibility, transfer of credits, and the role of existing institutions are discussed, together with ways in which continuing education could be provided for the whole community.

In discussing the administration and organisation of education the principle followed is the maximum devolution of authority and responsibility to the agencies and the community, at for instance, school committee and district level.
