A PROCLAMATION

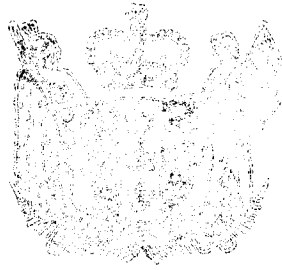
