New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement

Pursuant to Article 3 of the New Zealand – Australia Free Trade Agreement 1965, the products listed in the following Schedule have been nominated by New Zealand and Australia for addition to Schedule A.

Prior to formal inclusion in Schedule A, interested persons or firms are invited to make representations in support of or against any nominated product or products. The representations should be forwarded to the Secretary, Department of Trade and Industry, Private Bag, Wellington, not later than 15 November 1979 and the appropriate inquiries will be conducted. In those cases where the inquiries result in a decision to include the goods in Schedule A, and where the Australian Government is in agreement, such inclusion will be affected at the earliest practical date.

Products on which no representations against inclusion in Schedule A have been received by 15 November 1979 will be added to the Schedule on 1 January 1980 provided the Australian Government agrees.

Any person wishing to lodge an objection to New Zealand supporting these applications should do so in writing on or before 19 October 1979. Submissions should include a reference to the application number, tariff item and description of the goods concerned, be addressed to the Comptroller of Customs, Private Bag, Wellington, for the attention of the Director, Trade Division, and be supported by information as to the quality, range, supply, etc., of the goods or suitable alternative goods produced in New Zealand.
