A PROCLAMATION

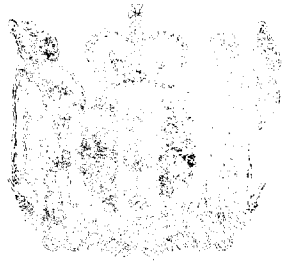
