A PROCLAMATION

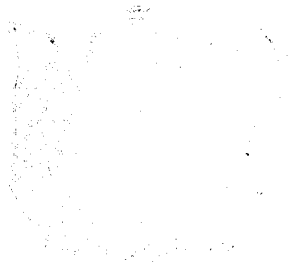
