Open Season for Game in Acclimatsation Districts— North Island and South Island

Pursuant to the Wildlife Act 1953, the Minister of Internal Affairs declares an open season for game, in the acclimatisa-tion districts, and subject to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule hereto, excepting the closed game areas published in the supplement to the New Zealand Gazette of 6 March 1980, and subject to any amendments in any subsequent Gazette notice, and in this notice.

The attention of sportsmen and others is drawn to the daily game possession limits set forth in the First Schedule hereto and to the provisions of the Wildlife Act 1953 and the Wildlife Regulations 1955.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Daily Game Possession Limit

EXCEPT where all game is labelled with the following details: (a) The name and address of the person by whom the

game was taken; (b) The number of the licence to hunt or kill game held

by the person by whom the game was taken; (c) The name of the acclimatisation society by which that

licence was issued; and
(d) The date on which the game was taken;

no person shall have in his possession on any one day game in excess of the following numbers:

North Island-

Saturday, 2 May 1981: A number of game corresponding to the number specified in this notification as the daily

bag limit. Sunday, 3 May 1981: Twice the number of game specified for Saturday, 2 May 1981.

Every subsequent day: As for Monday, 4 May 1981.

South Island-

Saturday, 11 April 1981: A number of game correspond-ing to the number specified in this notification as the daily bag limit.

Sunday, 12 April 1981: Twice the number of game specified for Saturday, 11 April 1981. Every subsequent day: As for Saturday, 11 April 1981.

Approval to Hunt or Kill Game During an Open Season for Game Where Food Has Been Cast, Thrown, Placed, or Planted

Approval is given for persons to hunt or kill game of the species listed below during an open season for game in the acclimatisation districts named hereto, where food has been cast, thrown, placed, or planted during the 1981-82 open season for game or during the period thirty (30) days immediately preceding the 1981-82 open season for game, and subject to the conditions specified hereto.

Excepting that temporarily moored floating stands may be used, no person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Waikare any stand, hide, maimai or loo, which is permanently fixed to the lake bed except within 180 metres of the outer margin of the said lake, or the shore-line of that island known as Motu Nuia or Grapa Island. or Grape Island.
- 2. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Ngaroto any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, except within 85 metres of the margin
- 3. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Rotokauri any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, on any open water of the said lake.
- 4. It shall be an offence for any person to wilfully leave on the hunting ground any black swan(s) shot or the mutilated bodies of any black swan(s) shot.
- 5. It shall be an offence for any person to herd or drive black swan(s) for the purpose of hunting or killing them.
- 6. It shall be an offence to shoot game from any unmoored boat on the Waikato River north of the boat ramp at the confluence of the Mangawara Stream and the Waikato River at Taupiri on any of the first 3 days or the second weekend of the open season.

No hut, mudhole, stand, hide, shelter, maimai, boat, louvre, or cylinder or other contrivance shall be used for the hunting or killing of game in any part of Lake Ellesmere in which the water is of a greater depth than 60 cm, excepting such areas as may be decided upon by the North Canterbury Acclimatisation Society, provided that nothing in this special condition shall prevent any person using any vessel for the purpose of retrieving game that has been killed or wounded wounded.
