Open Season for Game in Acclimatisation Districts-North Island and South Island

PURSUANT to the Wildlife Act 1953, the Minister of Internal Affairs declares an open season for game, in the acclimatisation districts, and subject to the conditions, specified in the Second Schedule hereto,

subject to the condutions, specified in the Second Schedule hereto, excepting the closed game areas published in the supplement to the New Zealand Gazette of 6 March 1980, and subject to any amendments in any subsequent Gazette notice, and in this notice. The attention of sportsmen and others is drawn to the daily game possession limits set forth in the First Schedule hereto and to the provisions of the Wildlife Act 1953 and the Wildlife Regulations 1955.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Daily Game Possession Limit

- EXCEPT where all game is labelled with the following details:
 - (a) The name and address of the person by whom the game was taken;
 - (b) The number of the licence to hunt or kill game held by the
 - person by whom the game was taken; (c) The name of the acclimatisation society by which that licence was issued; and (d) The date on which the game was taken;
- on person shall have in his possession on any one day game in excess of the following numbers:
- Saturday, 1 May 1982: A number of game corresponding to the number specified in this notification as the daily bag limit. Sunday, 2 May 1982: Twice the number of game specified for Saturday, 1 May 1982.
- Every subsequent day: As for Monday, 3 May 1982.

Approval to Hunt or Kill Game During an Open Season for Game Where Food has Been Cast, Thrown, Placed, or Planted

PURSUANT to section 17 of the Wildlife Act 1953, the Minister of Internal Affairs approves persons to hunt or kill game of the species listed below during an open season for game in the acclimatisation districts named hereto, where food has been cast, thrown, placed, or planted during the 1982 open season for game or during the period thirty (30) days immediately preceding the 1982 open season for game, and subject to the conditions specified hereto.

Game Species

Grey, shoveler (or spoonbill), mallard and paradise duck, black swan, and Canada goose.

North Canterbury Acclimatisation District. Otago Acclimatisation District. South Canterbury Acclimatisation District. Southern Lakes Acclimatisation District. Southland Acclimatisation District. Tauranga Acclimatisation District. Wanganui Acclimatisation District. Wellington Acclimatisation District. West Coast Acclimatisation District. Westland Acclimatisation District. Whangarei Acclimatisation District.

Conditions

1. The conditions specified for each Acclimatisation District under the Second Schedule shall apply.

2. This approval will expire at the end of the open season for game specified under the Second Schedule for each Acclimatisation District.

GAME AND JUNIOR GAME SEASON LICENCES AND LICENCE FEES

PURSUANT to the Wildlife Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 9, the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby prescribes the classes of licence to hunt or kill game that may be issued by an Acclimatisation Society in New Zealand for the 1982 open season for game, and approves the licence fees set and payable in respect of each class and the conditions attached thereto.

Class: New Zealand Game Season Licence.

Fee: Eighteen dollars (\$18)

Conditions: A New Zealand Game Season Licence shall enable the holder to hunt or kill game in all acclimatisation districts of New Zealand. The holder of the licence shall be subject to the conditions and daily possession limits specified under the Second Schedule for the acclimatisation district in which the hunting or killing of game takes place.

Class: Junior North Island Game Season Licence.

Conditions: Junior North Island Game Season Licences may be issued to persons up to 16 years of age or pupils attending school full time. The licence shall enable the holder to hunt or kill game within the acclimatisation districts of, Central North Island Wildlife Conservancy, Hawke's Bay, Stratford, Taranaki, Tauranga, Wanganui, Wellington and Whangarei. The holder of the licence shall be subject to the conditions and daily possession limits specified under the Second Schedule for the acclimatisation district in which the hunting or killing of game takes place. The provisions of the Arms Act 1958 apply with respect to firearms

used in accordance with the licence.

Class: Junior South Island Game Season Licence.

Paradise duck, 8

Chukor, 15

Fee: Five dollars (\$5). Conditions: Junior South Island Game Season Licences may be issued to persons up to 16 years of age and shall enable the holder to hunt or kill game in all acclimatisation districts of the South Island. The holder of the licence shall be subject to the conditions and daily possession limits specified under the Second Schedule for the acclimatisation district in which the hunting or killing of game takes place.

The provisions of the Arms Act 1958 apply with respect to firearms used in accordance with the licence.

The notice published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 36, 2 April 1981, p. 849—Game and Junior Game Season Licences and Licence Fees is hereby revoked.

1. Excepting that temporarily moored floating stands may be used, no person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Waikare any stand, hide, maimai or loo, which is permanently fixed to the lake bed except within 180 metres of the outer margin of the said lake, or the shore-line of that island known as Motu Nuia or Grape Island.

2. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Ngaroto any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, except within 85 metres of the margin of the said lake.

3. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Rotokauri any fixed stand, pontoon, hide, maimai, or loo, on any open water of the said lake.

4. It shall be an offence for any person to wilfully leave on the hunting ground any black swan(s) shot or the mutilated bodies of any black swan(s) shot.

5. It shall be an offence for any person to herd or drive black swan(s) for the purpose of hunting or killing them.

6. It shall be an offence to shoot game from any unmoored boat on the Waikato River north of the boat ramp at the confluence of the Mangawara Stream and the Waikato River at Taupiri on any of the first 3 days or the second weekend of the open season.

Open Season for Game in a Described Area of the Firth of Thames for the 1982 Game Season

An open season for game is declared in that area of the Firth of Thames hereinafter named the Firth of Thames Open Game Area and being that area that is enclosed between the boundary of the Auckland Acclimatisation District and a line connecting the points on that boundary by passing through Orere Point on the west side of the Firth and the southern headland of Fantail Bay on the Coromandel Peninsula subject to the conditions specified hereto and in the First Schedule.
