*Fixing Rate of Kiwifruit Levy 1983-84, (Notice No. 2988, Ag. 4/54/10/1)*

CORRIGENDUM

PURSUANT to regulation 18 of the Kiwifruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1977, as I have received a recommendation from the Kiwifruit Authority, I hereby give notice that:

*Customs Notice—Exchange Rates*

- (a) The rate of kiwifruit levy for the year ended 31 March 1984 shall be 53 cents in respect of each tray of kiwifruit exported.
- (b) The full amount of the levy shall be due and payable to the authority by the exporter when the tray is exported, but the exporter may recover from the producer an amount not exceeding 32 cents per tray.

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 28) 1982.  
(b) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1983.
