Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 32) 1982

PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973*, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives notice as follows:

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 32) 1982.
(b) This notice shall come into force on 16 April 1983.
2. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.
3. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the Second Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.
4. The exemption from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations in respect of the goods of the classes set forth in the Third Schedule hereto, included in the exemption notice shown in the Third Schedule is hereby withdrawn.
5. The exemption from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations in respect of the goods of the classes set forth in the Fourth Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, included in the exemption notice shown in the Fourth Schedule is hereby withdrawn.

Import Licence Tendering—Call for Tenders: Round 6

ANZCERT

PURSUANT to the Import Control Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 3 (S.R. 1980/246) and within the terms of the Australia – New Zealand Closer Economic Relations Trade Agreement, (ANZCERT) the Secretary of Trade and Industry, acting under delegated authority, is calling tenders for import licences (Tendered Australia Exclusive Licences—TEALS) for the goods specified below.

Guide notes to import licence tendering are set out below together with additional notes on special provisions introduced for tendering under ANZCERT.

Where reference is made in the Call for Tenders under ANZCERT to the provisions of the Agreement (e.g., in regard to white goods) tenderers can purchase copies of the Agreement from the bookshops of the Government Printer.

Tenders should be addressed to the Register of Tenders, P.O. Box 3146, Wellington or be delivered by hand to the 1st floor of the Bowen State Building, Wellington. Tenders for Round 6 should reach the Registrar no later than 5 p.m. on 30 May 1983. Envelopes should be marked "ANZCERT Tender".

Notes:

1. Tenderers are advised that some item codes contain tariff items that include goods which are exempt import licence or licence on demand when of Australian origin. It should be noted that the TEALS are not available for such goods because licences are not required for exempt goods and where goods are subject to licence on demand import licences are issued on application to the Collector of Customs.

2. The Call for Tenders contains a brief description of the goods being tendered. For a full identification of the goods concerned and other details, tenderers should refer to the Import Licensing Schedule and to the Customs Tariff and should consult the Department of Trade and Industry or the Customs Department.

3. Licences issued under this Call for Tenders will be for goods from Australia which comply with the ANZCERT rules of origin as detailed in the Agreement. Enquiries should be directed to the Collector of Customs.

4. Tenderers should be conversant with the various statutes and regulations governing the importation and sale of the goods tendered.

5. Tenderers should note that the number of TEAL licences allocated could be increased in some item codes where manufacturers return their MEAL licence allocation by 28 April 1983.

GUIDE TO IMPORT LICENCE TENDERING INCLUDING ANZCERT

INTRODUCTION

1. (a) The objectives of tendering are:

- to introduce more competition into the importing sector;
- to allocate import licences on an open and competitive basis;
- to widen the base of information available on industry competitiveness to facilitate the move away from protection by licensing to tariffs.

(b) Tendering applies to certain import licences for various commodities to be announced from time to time. It derives from the Import Control Regulations 1973 Amendment No. 3 and is administered by the Department of Trade and Industry under delegated authority from the Minister of Trade and Industry. Within the department a Registrar, Import Licence Tendering, appointed by the Secretary of Trade and Industry is in charge of the specific functions of the scheme.

(c) As part of each Call for Tender the department will publish the total value of licences for each product category. Each product category is assigned a separate tender number. Goods covered by each tender number can be identified in greater detail by referring to the relevant tariff items in the New Zealand Customs Tariff.

(d) The Calls for Tenders will be advertised in the *Gazette*. Copies of which will be available from all Government Bookshops.

Tenderers who have Registered will receive by mail a copy of the *Gazette* containing the call for tenders plus all necessary forms and information.

Press advertisements will give general descriptions only of goods offered for tender, and the dates of the closing and opening of each Round.

Unregistered Tenderers will need to obtain a copy of the *Gazette* from Government Bookshops for fuller details of items offered for tender.

(e) Any enterprise as defined in section 4 below is eligible to bid in response to a specific Call for Tender issued by the department.

(f) The successful tenderers will be those who submit the highest valid bids for the available licence units in each tender number. A bid of less than \$5.00 is not acceptable.

(g) Results of all tenders will be published in the *Gazette* which is available at Government Bookshops.

Government Bookshops are located at Hannaford Burton Building, Rutland Street (Private Bag, C.P.O.), Auckland 1; Northern Automobile Building, Alexandra Street (P.O. Box 857), Hamilton; Head Office, Mulgrave Street (Private Bag), Wellington 1; Wellington Trade Centre, Cubacade (Private Bag), Wellington 1; Avon House, 130 Oxford Terrace (Private Bag), Christchurch 1; T. and G. Building, Princes Street (P.O. Box 1104), Dunedin.

(h) Except as may be stipulated in this guide, licences granted under tendering will be subject to the usual procedures, and terms and conditions, laid down pursuant to the Import Control Regulations 1973, and nothing in these guidelines shall limit any provision of those regulations.

(i) The goods imported will be subject to the appropriate rate of duty and sales tax where applicable. The assessment of sales tax payable on goods imported under tender licences will include the amount of the tender bid.

(j) Licences obtained under Import Licence Tendering will not count towards history for the general import licensing system and will not be taken into account in the administration of any policies under the general system.

CALLS FOR TENDER

2. Calls for Tenders will specify the item code; the tariff item; a brief description of the goods involved; the total value of licences to be tendered under each tender number; the maximum number of licence units that can be tendered for and the value of each licence unit.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TENDERER TO ENSURE THAT THE GOODS TO BE IMPORTED AGAINST A GIVEN TENDER NUMBER ARE CORRECTLY CLASSIFIED IN A TARIFF ITEM THAT IS INCLUDED IN THE RELEVANT TENDER NUMBER.

SPARE PARTS AND SERVICE

3. For certain tender numbers marked with an asterisk the tenderer will be required to indicate that a satisfactory spare parts and back-up service will be provided. Provision for this has been made on the tender bid form. Where an undertaking has previously been given a reference to the Tender Number where that undertaking may be found will be sufficient.

WHO CAN BID

4. (a) Tenders may be submitted by any enterprise domiciled in New Zealand which has actively traded in goods or services for the 12 months preceding the calling of tenders.

(b) For the purposes of the scheme, enterprise, does not include:

- (i) any social, recreational or sporting club, any charitable or religious institution, or any person not principally engaged in carrying on a business for financial reward; or
- (ii) any person who in the opinion of the Secretary of Trade and Industry has not actively traded in goods or services for the 12 months preceding the calling of a tender; or
- (iii) any person who has been granted a licence under these provisions but who, not having lawfully assigned his licence or not having received an extension of the end date for licence usage fails to import goods under that licence to the value of 75 percent of that licence within the validity period of the licence providing there are no sound commercial reasons for its non-usage.

- (iv) any person who has submitted a tender under these provisions but who in the opinion of the Secretary of Trade and Industry—
 —has failed to fulfil any undertaking given to the Secretary relating to the taking up of any licence under the Scheme; or
 —has made any false or misleading statement in relation to any tender submitted or any licence granted under tendering. (Tenderers are also referred to Section M of the Import Licensing Schedule.)

LIMITATIONS ON BIDS

5. (a) No one enterprise may submit bids for more than the stipulated maximum number of licence units being offered for tender within each tender number. Where this does occur those bids in that tender number will be declared invalid. Tenderers must be conversant with the various statutes and regulations which apply to tendering and to importing such as safety standards, duties, sales tax, etc.
 (b) Those tenderers whose payment for previous bids are overdue or will be at the opening date of the next Round, will have to attach a bank cleared cheque for the amount overdue. Failure to do so will invalidate the bids.

TENDERING FORMAT

6. (a) Forms are available from Collectors of Customs and the Department of Trade and Industry. Registered tenderers will receive a copy of the *New Zealand Gazette* containing the Call for Tenders, a supply of bid forms and notes as appropriate.
 (b) Please use the new bid forms (T & I 335 Blue form). A separate form is required for each tender number. Where a tender number allows several bids under that number (e.g., 2 or 3 units) these may be recorded on the same bid form. This allows you to put several bids for the same tender number on one form.

PLEASE DO NOT USE PHOTOCOPIES OF THE FORM.

All details must be typed.

It is not longer necessary to post each bid separately. . . . *No duplicates are required.*

- (c) Bids submitted on behalf of tenderers must be by fully authorised agents.

DEADLINES AND PROCEDURES

7. (a) Tenders must be received by 5 p.m. on the due date by the REGISTRAR, IMPORT LICENCE TENDERING, DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY, P.O. BOX 3146, WELLINGTON. There will be no extension of the deadline specified in the Call for Tenders unless in exceptional circumstances.
 (b) Tenders may be mailed to the above address or delivered by hand to the First Floor Reception, Bowen State Building, Wellington. Envelopes should be clearly marked IMPORT LICENCE TENDER. Hand deliveries may be made between 8.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday, except public holidays.
 (c) In the event of a tie for licence units, the lowest winning bids will be selected by the computer programme on a random basis.
 (d) Tenderers may withdraw or amend their tenders if they notify the Registrar of Tenders in writing prior to the opening of tenders.

ADVICE AND PUBLICATION

8. (a) Following the closing of tenders, bids will be publicly opened in the department's boardroom in Wellington in the presence of a Justice of the Peace. The bids are not opened in Tender number order and for this reason and the volume of bids received, these are no longer read out.
 (b) Tenderers will be individually notified by letter and Invoice. Computer printouts of all results are sent to the regional offices of the department.
 (c) The name and location of all tenderers, successful, unsuccessful and invalid, and the amount bid in each case, will be published in the *Gazette* as soon as possible after the opening of tenders.
 (N.B.: The specific goods to be brought in will not be published.)

PAYMENT OF THE SUCCESSFUL BID

9. (a) An enterprise which has been successful in obtaining a licence may not withdraw its bid. The enterprise in submitting a tender has in effect entered into a contract with the department and must fulfil its obligation to pay the sum tendered.
 (b) The amount bid by an enterprise will be payable to the Department of Trade and Industry, Wellington, from the date of the invoice notifying success. The bid must be paid before the licence can be issued from Head Office, Trade and Industry and no later than six months after the date of the invoice. Payment should be made to the Finance Officer, Department of Trade and Industry, Private Bag, Wellington.

VALIDITY OF LICENCES OBTAINED BY TENDER

10. (a) Licences issued under the tendering scheme will be valid for one year from the date of the invoice unless otherwise stated. Extensions will be considered only in exceptional circumstances.
 (b) Licences will not be transferable to other item codes, inside or outside the tendering scheme unless the itm codes are within the same tender number.
 (c) Licences may not be assigned to third parties without prior written consent of the department.

STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS

12. The issue of an import licence under the tendering scheme will in no way affect the obligation of the tenderer to comply with other relevant statutes and regulations. See Section N of the Import Licensing Schedule.

LICENCE USAGE RETURNS

Licence usage return forms may be issued for certain tenders. Where successful tenderers do receive these forms, they must be completed and returned to the Registrar of Tenders.

OPERATIVE DATE

This guide is operative as from the date of this *Gazette* and supersedes other guides to import licence tendering.

TENDERING UNDER ANZCERT

These notes are additional to the Guide to Import Licence Tendering set out above. Similar procedures for lodging bids will be followed for tendering under ANZCERT as under normal tendering. However, there are some special provisions under ANZCERT which you should be aware of. These are:

- (a) Licences won under the first round of ANZCERT tendering will be available for the 18 month period 1 January 1983 to 30 June 1984. Initially the licences will be issued for a 12 month period and provision will be made to extend the validity of the licence to 30 June 1984 where necessary. Only in exceptional circumstances will they be extended beyond that period.

(b) A tender period of six weeks from notification in the *New Zealand Gazette* will apply.

(c) It is recognised that, because the value of ANZCERT licence put up for tender in some item codes is relatively large compared to the total value of global licence issued in that item code, importers under the tendering scheme may face uncertainty about future licence for developing the market for the imported products. Provision has been made for successful tenderers in the first period to obtain licences for the 1984/85 period equal to one-third of the value of licence won in the first (18 month) period in such circumstances. The 1984/85 licence would be obtained on payment of one-third of the premium bid by that tenderer in the first place.

The item codes with provision for this arrangement will be notified before the 1984/85 call for tenders for ANZCERT licence.

(d) A manufacturer including its subsidiaries or associates, which receives part of the manufacturers' allocation of Exclusive Australian Licence in a particular item code, will not be entitled to bid in those item codes under the tendering scheme.

A company will be ineligible to tender in an item code if another company holding Manufacturers' Exclusive Australian Licence (MEAL) in the same item code has more than a 25 percent shareholding connection with the first company, either directly or indirectly. Companies which do not observe this principle will face the risk of having their tendered EAL's revoked. It should be noted that details of both manufacturer's and tendered EAL's will be published.

(e) Manufacturers including their subsidiaries or associates have the option of foregoing a share of the manufacturers' allocation in return for the right to tender in which case the group of companies may bid as under normal tendering.

(f) The licences to be issued for Tendered Exclusive Australian Licences (TEALs) will be type 9 and will be printed in red type to distinguish these from ordinary tender licences. Premiums are payable within six months. Licences will be issued from Wellington as at present.

(g) Some flexibility will be exercised in relation to the 12 month trading qualification for ANZCERT tendering. Any potential tenderer who has not traded for 12 months but wishes to tender for ANZCERT licence should write to the Registrar of Tenders and supply details of the trading history to date, i.e., date company registered, copy of company seal, goods and services traded, etc.

(h) The new yellow bid forms for ANZCERT tendering are designed to allow bids to be made through the Bureaufax Service of the GPO where desired.
