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Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 4) 1985-86

PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973*, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice:

NOTICE

(1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 4) 1985-86.
 (2) Except as provided in clause 4 (2) of this notice, this notice shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1985.

2. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff Items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.

3. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations in respect of the goods of the classes set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, included in the exemption notices shown in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby withdrawn.

4. (1) The Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1985-86† and the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 3) 1985-86‡ are hereby revoked.

(2) This clause shall come into force on the 31st day of December 1984.

EXPLANATORY NOTE: This exemption notice, which comes into force on 1 January 1985, provides for the exemption, in terms of the ANZCERT Agreement, of certain goods imported from Australia. This notice replaces two other notices, namely, the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1985-86 and the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 3) 1985-86, which were to have come into force on that date.

This notice differs from the notices it replaces in that it will not exempt the following goods:

Common salt, not iodised (excluding refined salt, not iodised in packs 4.5 kg or less)

Fabric in the piece composed of textile fibres or yarns tufted into knitted fabrics exceeding 30 cm in width Knitted or crocheted fabrics of cotton

Knitted or crocheted fabrics (other than fabric of wool or fine animal hair or of cotton or of man made fibres) Knitted or crocheted elastic fabric
