TENDERS CLOSE ON 18 MARCH 1985 AT 5 PM.

PURSUANT to the Import Control Regulations 1973 (S.R. 1980/246) the Secretary of Trade and Industry, acting under delegated authority is calling tenders for the goods specified below. Tenders close on 18 March 1985 at 5 p.m. and must be received by the Registrar of Tenders by then to be valid.

Instructions for tenderers and the general terms and conditions which apply to the submission and acceptance of tenders are set out in the Guide to Licence Tendering dated November 1984. Tenders should be addressed to the Registrar of Tenders, P.O. Box 3146, Wellington, or be delivered by hand to the First Floor of the Bowen State Building, Wellington. Tenders for Round 21 should reach the Registrar no later than 5 p.m. on 18 March 1985.

NOTE:

1. Tenderers should refer to the Customs Tariff and the Import Licensing Schedule for a definitive description of the goods included in the list below.
2. Tenderers should be conversant with the various statutes and regulations which importing enterprises are obliged to comply with.
3. Bids may be sent in one envelope. The envelope must be marked Import Licence Tender.

FRUIT CANNING INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Please note the difference in format for this tender. To keep the tender in line with previous tenders under this Development Plan, the unit size is \$50,000 not \$2,000 and no bidder may bid for more than 4 units or \$200,000 of licence in total. Manufacturers that have accepted an allocation in terms of the plan, and any subsidiary, are not eligible to tender.
