IMPORT CONTROL EXEMPTION
NOTICE (NO. 5) 1986

Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 5) 1986

PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973*, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 5) 1986.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1986.
2. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.
3. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the Second Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.
4. Goods of the classes specified in the Third Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.
5. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations, in respect of the classes of goods set forth in the Fourth Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, included in the exemption notices shown in the Fourth Schedule, are hereby withdrawn.
6. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations, in respect of the classes of goods set forth in the Fifth Schedule, are hereby withdrawn.
7. The exemption from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations, in respect of the classes of goods set forth in the Sixth Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, included in the exemption notice shown in the Sixth Schedule, is hereby withdrawn.

SIXTH SCHEDULE

EXEMPTION WITHDRAWN

- Goods (other than television advertising video tape and television advertising film,) which—
- (1) do not exceed in value in respect of any one importation the sum of one hundred dollars \$100 (CIF and E New Zealand currency); and
 - (2) are not part of an ongoing arrangement to import on a regular basis; and
 - (3) are not imported in connection with a contract of sale and purchase whenever effected, which has been negotiated or solicited in New Zealand; and
 - (4) are not imported at the same time as any other goods despatched from the same country of origin by the same exporter—
- Provided that goods imported at the same time as any other despatched from the same country of origin by the same exporter shall be allowed the benefit of this exemption if the importer satisfied the Collector of Customs by such evidence as the Collector deems sufficient, that the goods comply with all other conditions of this exemption

EXPLANATORY NOTE: This notice provides for—

- (a) The exemption of a large range of goods, including various articles of metal, certain types of toys and several items that have been subject to the global licence on demand procedure for some time;
- (b) Exemption of goods from Australia, to meet our obligations under the ANZCERT Agreement and to provide inter alia that all goods subject to 'global licence on demand' are exempt from Australia; and
- (c) to amend existing exemptions to maintain alignment with the Customs Tariff as amended by the Customs Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1986.
