New Zealand Railways Corporation General Scale of Charges Notice: Amendment No. 16

PURSUANT to the New Zealand Railways Corporation Act 1981, the New Zealand Railways Corporation hereby makes the following alterations and additions to the General Scale of Charges dated the 9th day of July 1982*, and hereby declares that such alterations and additions shall come into force on the dates specified below:

Clause 7.2.1 Auckland suburban system school season tickets only.

Section 8.3 to Section 8.6 inclusive. Auckland suburban fares.

With effect from the 3rd day of August 1986.

All other alterations and additions, with effect from the date of publication of this notice.

The Auckland-Wellington adult ordinary fare is \$64.00. The Auckland-Wellington adult sleeper fare is \$90.00. The Auckland-Wellington children, eligible beneficiaries or blind persons and attendants fare

is \$58.00 (as eligible under clause 2.10). Fares to and between intermediate timetabled stopping stations are as shown in the Corporation's Fares and Timetable booklet. The minimum fare for a sleeping berth shall be \$46.20 adult and \$36.10 child, eligible beneficiary or blind person and attendant (as eligible under clause 2.10).

4.3: Southerner service fares

The Christchurch–Invercargill adult single ordinary fare is \$39.20. Fares to and between intermediate timetabled stopping stations are as shown in the Corporation's Fares and Timetable booklet.

4.4: Wellington–Gisborne service fares

The Wellington–Gisborne adult single ordinary fare is \$42.00. Fare to and between intermediate timetabled stopping stations are as shown in the Corporation's Fares and Timetable booklet.

4.5: Wellington–Palmerston North via Wairarapa service fares

The Wellington–Palmerston North via Wairarapa adult single ordinary fare is \$17.50. Fares to and between intermediate timetabled stopping stations are as shown in the Corporation's Fares and Timetable booklet.

4.6: Christchurch–Picton service fares

The Christchurch–Picton adult single ordinary fare is \$28.00. Fares to and between intermediate timetabled stopping stations are as shown in the Corporation's Fares and Timetable booklet.”

The Christchurch–Greymouth adult single fare is \$19.00. Fares to and between intermediate timetabled stopping stations are as shown in the Corporation's Fares and Timetable booklet.”
