Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1988

PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973*, ("the regulations'') the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice:

NOTICE

- 1 (1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1988.
 - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1988.
- Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the regulations.
- Goods of the classes specified in the Second Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the regulations.
- Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the Third Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit

under the regulations.

- 5 Goods of the classes specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of the Cook Islands, Niue or Western Samoa, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the said regulations.
- Goods of the classes specified in the Fifth Schedule hereto, imported from Pacific Forum Island Countries that are signatories to the South Pacific Regional Trade and Economic Co-operation Agreement (SPARTECA), are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the regulations.
- 7 The Import Control Exemption Notices set forth in the Sixth Schedule hereto, being notices given pursuant to regulation 17 of the regulations, are hereby revoked.
- 8 Where in the First and Third Schedules to this notice, the expression 'Ex' appears beside a Tariff item, the exemption from the requirement of a licence or permit created by this notice shall only apply to the class or classes of goods specified as applying to the Tariff item.

Passengers' baggage and effects imported under Tariff Ref 80 of Part II of the Customs Tariff which are not intended for any other person or persons or for gift, sale, or exchange

A motor vehicle, which is the personal property of the importer, and has been owned and used by the importer, and registered in the name of the importer overseas for a period of 90 days prior to delivery for export to New Zealand. Provided that:

 - b In labour and factory overheads incurred in the Cook Islands, Niue, or Western Samoa and/or in New Zealand; or
 - c In inner containers that are of the Cook Islands, Niue, or Western Samoa and/or New Zealand origin; or
 - d Partly in such materials and partly in such other items of factory cost (including inner containers) as aforesaid - is not less than one half of the factory or works cost of the goods in this finished state;
 - iii That in the calculation of the proportion of expenditure in material, and/or in other items of factory or works cost incurred in the Cook Islands, Niue, or Western Samoa or in those areas and/or New Zealand, none of the following items has been included or considered, viz: manufacturer's profit, or the profit or remuneration of any trader, agent, broker, or other person dealing in the goods in their finished conditions; royalties payable in respect of the finished goods; cost of outside packages or any cost of packing the goods into them; administrative and general office expenses; any cost of conveying, insuring or shipping the goods, or any charges incurred after their manufacture
