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**Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1988**

PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973\*, ('the regulations') the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice:

**NOTICE**

- 1 (1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 1) 1988.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1988.
- 2 Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the regulations.
- 3 Goods of the classes specified in the Second Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the regulations.
- 4 Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the Tariff items in the Third Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit

under the regulations.

5 Goods of the classes specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of the Cook Islands, Niue or Western Samoa, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the said regulations.

6 Goods of the classes specified in the Fifth Schedule hereto, imported from Pacific Forum Island Countries that are signatories to the South Pacific Regional Trade and Economic Co-operation Agreement (SPARTECA), are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence or permit under the regulations.

7 The Import Control Exemption Notices set forth in the Sixth Schedule hereto, being notices given pursuant to regulation 17 of the regulations, are hereby revoked.

8 Where in the First and Third Schedules to this notice, the expression 'Ex' appears beside a Tariff item, the exemption from the requirement of a licence or permit created by this notice shall only apply to the class or classes of goods specified as applying to the Tariff item.

Passengers' baggage and effects imported under Tariff Ref 80 of Part II of the Customs Tariff which are not intended for any other person or persons or for gift, sale, or exchange -

- a Wearing apparel and other personal effects which are the property of the person bringing them to New Zealand;

consent of the Minister

A motor vehicle, which is the personal property of the importer, and has been owned and used by the importer, and registered in the name of the importer overseas for a period of 90 days prior to delivery for export to New Zealand. Provided that:

- b For the purposes of this exemption the expression 'used' means driven by the importer, on public roads, other than for the purpose of, or for purposes incidental to, testing or registering the vehicle, or delivering the vehicle for export to New Zealand.

- 1 are carried in the same vessel or aircraft as the passenger; and
- 2 are for the passengers' own personal use or as bona fide personal gifts; and

- 4 are not imported on behalf of any other person or persons
