Government Notices**Agriculture and Fisheries****Animal Remedies Act 1967****Licenses Issued Under the Animal Remedies Act 1967 (Notice No. 4447; Ag. 6/15/5/2)**

Pursuant to sections 21 (6) and 29 of the Animal Remedies Act 1967, the Registrar of Animal Remedies hereby gives notice that licenses have been issued, have lapsed or have been varied as set out in the Schedules hereto;

1. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule I are new licenses issued, not subject to conditions.
2. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule II are new licenses issued subject to the conditions:
 - (a) That the remedy shall not be sold to any other person other than a Veterinary Surgeon, or a Dealer or otherwise than pursuant to the prescription of a Veterinary Surgeon; and
 - (b) That the remedy shall not be used otherwise than by or under the supervision of a Veterinary Surgeon.
3. The remedies listed in Schedule III are provisionally licensed subject to the conditions shown in respect of them.
4. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule IV are licenses which have lapsed or have been withdrawn by the licensee.
5. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule V are licenses in respect to which there has been a change in the trade name of the animal remedy.

Decision

These publications were privately imported at Auckland in December 1987, and subsequently seized by the Collector of Customs at Auckland. The importer has disputed forfeiture and the books have accordingly been referred to the Tribunal prior to the commencement of condemnation proceedings pursuant to the Customs Act 1966.

Both of these publications consist essentially of photographs with a small amount of accompanying text and those photographs are principally of the nude or semi-nude male with occasional photographs of two or more males. Some of the photographs in each of the magazines cause the tribunal some concern, but that concern was insufficient to warrant an unconditional indecent classification.

The Tribunal is satisfied however, that both publications would be injurious to younger readers, and accordingly classifies each as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years.

This publication was privately imported at Auckland on 4 January 1988, and seized by the Collector of Customs. The importer has disputed forfeiture and the book has therefore been referred to the Tribunal prior to the commencement of condemnation proceedings pursuant to the Customs Act 1966.

Following notification by the Indecent Publications Tribunal,

that this matter would be the subject of a public hearing, the importer wrote to the Tribunal that he would like to make submissions in respect of the matter before the Tribunal. The Tribunal received and considered a very lengthy typewritten submission from the importer but neither the time available for the preparation of decisions, nor the workload on the Tribunal permits that they care for analysis of that submission.

The Tribunal agrees with the Comptroller of Customs that this is a poor quality hardcore pornographic homosexual magazine that deals in a most explicit way with the practice of 'fisting' or the insertion of the hand into the anus and then forming a clenched fist. The Tribunal on a viewing of the publication was unanimous that it was clearly injurious to the public good to have such a publication available in this country and accordingly classifies this publication as unconditionally indecent.

Decision of a Minority: Ms R. Barrington

The publishers and importers of these magazines sought a restriction order in respect of these publications under section 15A of the Indecent Publications Act 1963. The effect of the granting of such an order is that for a period of time not exceeding 2 years every issue of these magazines imported into New Zealand would automatically be given the same classification as that determined for these particular issues; that is indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years. I oppose the granting of such an order for two sets of reasons; firstly relating to the consistency and content of the magazines; and secondly, to the way in which the distributors intend to market this magazine, and the lack of control over these outlets.

Firstly the consistency and content of *Knave* and *Fiesta*. The Tribunal had before it 18 past copies of *Knave* and 33 copies of *Fiesta* and three issues of each magazine intended for future distribution.

Counsel for the publishers outlined the "John Menzies Guidelines" and the Galaxy Publications Ltd. Advertising Guidelines with which it was agreed the magazines are required to comply when for sale in the United Kingdom. The detailed aspects of these guidelines include specifying what is allowable on the covers, in photographs, text and advertisements of the magazines, the distribution of the magazines and the display and sale of the magazines.

To expand upon these, the magazines should not on their covers "show a detailed photograph of the vaginal area, penis, testes, or anus, nor should it allow any sexual activity or over provocative pose by the model."

The advertising guidelines state that for photographs or

drawings "nudity is of course acceptable, but should avoid the following: [a] to [t] is listed and include the following:

[k] forceful sexual activity (e.g., rape).

[r] flagellation and bondage.

Past copies which were available to the Tribunal did not show a complete consistency with respect to the above matters. Earlier copies included advertising for bondage and sado masochist activities and some copies showed some photographs in which the models were posed in the context suggestive of violence. Covers of earlier editions of the magazines did not always comply with the arguably subjective criteria that "they should not display over provocative poses by the model." The criteria governing the magazines allowed photographs depicting violence in the video review sections. There was insufficient explanation from the publishers as to their policy with respect to the selection of photographs from videos and films, although this was sought by the Tribunal. This lack of consistency over past issues is material when considering a restriction order.

Secondly if a restriction order were to be granted, the issue of where these magazines are to be displayed and sold is relevant. The Indecent Publications Act is largely silent over what constitutes the offence of exhibiting an indecent document in or within view of a public place [section 21], and is totally silent on how that restriction is to be enforced, when the Tribunal declares a publication indecent in the hands of persons under a particular age. There are no enforcement provisions available to the Tribunal over the display of material referred to the Tribunal.

The publishers "Menzies Guidelines" contain very explicit policy on the display covering these magazines.

MENZIES GUIDELINES

6. *Display of Magazines:* The company considers it desirable that care should be taken not to offend customers who may not choose to purchase adult magazines. It is also considered essential that there should be no sale to those under the age of 16 years. The company has borne in mind that the age of majority is 18 and that the age of consent (in Scotland) for marriage and for sexual intercourse is 16. Accordingly, there seems to be no logical reason why adult publications should not be sold to those of 16 years of age and over. The policy on display is accordingly:

(a) No magazine should be displayed or available for sale at points where under sixteens can have ready and immediate access to them, i.e., at front of the counter.

(b) Wherever possible, adult titles should be placed on higher shelves or on displays or if on a sales counter, adjacent to the sales assistants' normal stance. They should be so placed that some supervision can be exercised by the sales staff only for the purpose of preventing the under sixteens having access to them.

(c) No adult magazine should be sold by or to an under 16 year old. If in any doubt the sale should be refused.

(d) Adult magazines should not be placed adjacent to children's comics, or magazines for young people but beside other magazines more likely to be purchased generally by adults.

(e) Retail outlets should be careful to exercise a discretion in displaying covers which, though within the general policy, might cause offence due to the location of the retail outlet.

The company welcomes continued advice from its staff, from those engaged in law enforcement and from its customers as to its policy in the light of contemporary community standards."

While it may be possible to enforce these Guidelines in the United Kingdom, under the present New Zealand legislation there is no way of enforcing this policy. Copies of these magazines are on display in New Zealand retail outlets in ways which transgress these Guidelines.

Gordon and Gotch are distributing up to 20 000 copies of these magazines per month. They are distributed to bookshops, magazine sections of larger stores, and corner dairies. There is nothing on the cover of these publications to indicate to whom they are available [in comparison with Australian states], or that the Tribunal has imposed an R 18 age restriction on them. Little control exists over who purchases these magazines at the retail outlets; and there is even less control over who may browse through them when they are readily accessible. While these magazines have the objective of "light hearted amusement and providing mild titillation" according to the publisher's counsel, there is also an argument that they denigrate the female body to such an extent and manner that all issues should not be easily available for the next two years to school children to browse through while deciding how to spend their pocket money. Accordingly the granting of a restriction order is opposed.

Decision

Although there was no formal appearance on behalf of the importer, a written submission was received from him and this was considered by the Tribunal along with the other submission of the Comptroller of Customs.

These two magazines were privately imported at Hamilton in November 1987. The Collector of Customs seized the magazines and the importer disputed forfeiture. The publications were therefore referred to the Tribunal prior to the commencement of condemnation proceedings pursuant to the Customs Act 1966.

In his submission on behalf of the Comptroller of Customs, Mr Wotherspoon described the publication in this manner:

"These are graphic homosexual publications clearly depicting oral and anal sex, with sado-masochistic overtones in some photographs. There is virtually no text with each publication consisting of a series of colour photographs."

Mr Wotherspoon went on in his submission to submit to the Tribunal that these publications were to be considered in the same class as *Submissive Suck-Off* a publication which the Tribunal had described as "explicit hardcore homosexual pornography" when classifying it as unconditionally indecent in Decision No. 25/87 of 16 December 1987.

In his submission to the Tribunal, the importer expressed his anger that the Tribunal was to become involved in a transaction which he considered personal and private. The importer informed the Tribunal that he resented the fact that he as an adult, should have his sexual morality subjected to the valued judgments of someone else, whether that person be an agent of the Customs Department, or a member of the

Tribunal. The importer then went on to schedule a number of matters which he asked the Tribunal to take into account in considering the publications before it. We set out hereunder his submissions as presented to us in that regard:

- "1. I am 39 years old, so legally Adult.
2. I am not associated with any commercial organisation or activity.
- 3a. The transaction which lead to the seizure of the two magazines was initially private and between two adult individuals.
 - b. Because this was a private transaction, the magazines were not for sale or distribution, and the content therefore not for public dissemination.
 - c. Because the magazines were not for sale or distribution, the content therefore would not have been "Injurious to the public good."
- 4a. Not having seen the magazines yet, I can only assume that the actors shown are adults.
 - b. The tribunal will be aware that homosexual acts are not illegal in this country, between consenting adults, in private.
 - c. I assume the magazines were submitted because they show sexual activity?
 - d. I question then, whether the sexual activity shown in the magazines (*sic*) is illegal in this country?
- 5a. The magazines were purchased for me, at my request, in response to an advertisement in *The Advocate*, an American magazine on sale in this country. (Issue No. 479, dated 18 August 1987, page 99).
 - b. The advertisement states that the magazines are taken from videos.
 - c. In *Out*, a magazine published in this country, there appears an advertisement for a video called *Powertool*, starring Jeff Stryker, the subject of one of the magazines now in question. (Issue No. 74, dated August 1987, page 36).
 - d. The advertisement states that the video in on sale to persons 18 years and over.
6. Fellatio, anal intercourse, masturbation whether solitary or mutual, and the use of sex aids, is shown in adult videos, whether they have heterosexual or homosexual content, which are available for purchase or hire in this country.
7. I find it ludicrous that as an adult, I can legally participate in the sexual activity mentioned in paragraph 6, and view the same form of activity shown explicitly in videos, but according to someone else's judgement, should not be able to view this sexual activity in a magazine."

In conclusion the importer pointed out that the transaction, that is the receipt of the magazines would have remained private but for the intervention on what he could only interpret as moral grounds by some third party. The importer formally requested that the magazines be forwarded to him.

The Tribunal has some sympathy for this importer as in fact it has for most private importers in cases where the stated sole use to be made of the publications is for the personal reading of the importer in question. The legislation however, does not enable the Tribunal, as we interpret our obligations, to determine such matters simply on the basis of a solo import by a private importer.

The Tribunal finds the magazines to be graphic homosexual publications with many depictions of oral and anal sex with sado-masochistic overtones in some photographs and with virtually no text and in our view the magazines are devoid of any literary, artistic or other merit. They are in effect explicit hard core homosexual magazines and just as the Tribunal would find such magazines dealing with heterosexual subjects to be unconditionally indecent so to in the case of both of these

magazines, the Tribunal classifies them as unconditionally indecent.

The Tribunal has delivered its decision in respect of those other publications and has found them to be indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years and in addition, has granted a serial order in respect of both the publications *Knave* and *Fiesta*. It is a mere formality that the Tribunal therefore in respect of these publications declares them to be indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years.
