Any person wishing to lodge an objection must do so in writing, to the ** Port of lodgement indicated by the reference number, before 2 May 1989. All submissions must include:
- the Tariff Industry Assistance (Advertisement) Notice number;
 - the Tariff item;
 - the Port; and
 - Reference number.
- 2 All submissions from local manufacturers must include:
- the range of alternative goods made locally;
 - the grounds on which objection is made (including reasons why the local product is a suitable alternative);
 - present and potential output;
 - details of factory cost in terms of materials, labour, overheads, including the proportion of domestic and imported content.
- 3 All submissions objecting to a request for the imposition of duty must include:
- reasons why the local product on which protection is sought is not a suitable alternative;
 - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the port where the application was lodged quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.
- 5 Any submission not supported by the information required in the paragraphs above will not be regarded as a valid objection.

Decisions of the Minister of Commerce in respect of Part I and Part II of the Tariff

- 1 Notice is hereby given that the following decisions have been made in respect of the goods published in the Schedules to this notice.
- 2 SCHEDULE 2 - Decisions cancelled. The cancellations listed in this schedule take effect fourteen days from *Gazette* date unless otherwise specified, eg, WEF (date).

CUSTOMS EXCHANGE RATES NOTICE (NO. 9) 1989

Pursuant to section 143 of the Customs Act 1966, the Comptroller of Customs, in accordance with the power delegated to him by the Minister of Customs under section 9 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 9) 1989.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 24th day of April 1989.

2. Exchange rates - Where under any provisions of the Customs Act 1966 any amount which is required to be taken into account for the purpose of assessing duty or any other purpose is not an amount in New Zealand currency, the amount to be so taken into account shall be the equivalent in New Zealand currency of that amount ascertained in accordance with the rate of exchange set out in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Revocation - The Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 8) 1989, published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, Customs Edition No. 56, dated 28th March 1989, on page 1258 is hereby revoked.
