**Commerce****Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988****Preliminary Determination and Imposition of Provisional Measures: Dumping Investigation in Respect of Canned Catfood**

**Customs****Customs Act 1966****Exclusive Australian Tariff Quota Tendering—No. 2 Call for Tenders 1989**

Pursuant to section 120 (5) of the Customs Act 1966, the Comptroller of Customs, acting under the delegated authority is calling tenders for Australian Tariff Quota for grape wine of an FOB value of less than \$2.00 per litre.

Guide notes to Australian Tariff Quota Tendering are set out below:

Tenders must be addressed to the Collector of Customs, P.O. Box 66, Nelson. *Attention:* T. Heine or delivered by hand to the Fourth Floor, 241 Hardy Street, Nelson. Tenders should reach the office of the Collector of Customs no later than 4 p.m. on Thursday, 18 May 1989. Envelopes must be marked "Exclusive Australian Tariff Quota Tender No. 2."

**Notes**

1. Tenders are advised that Tariff quota allocations issued under this call for tenders will be for the importation of grape wine classified under Tariff headings 2204 and 2205 (See further on for Schedule of relevant Tariff items).
2. Tenderers should be conversant with the various statutes and regulations governing the importation and sale of wine.

**Guide to Tariff Quota Tendering**

1. Tenderers are to express their bids as an amount per litre (e.g. 20c per litre) even though the quotas will be issued on a value basis.
2. Quotas will be allocated to the successful tenderers on the basis of the number of Tariff Quota allocation sizes. The successful tenderers will receive a duty concession, issued under reference 99 of Part II of the Customs Tariff, for Tariff Headings 2204 and 2205 which will reduce the rate of duty down to the level of the bid plus the relevant rate set out in the New Zealand Tariff. *Example:* A bid of 20c per litre under Tariff Item 2204.21.09 would mean the concession rate would be \$1.69 per litre.

### Who Can Bid?

Tenders may be submitted by any person or enterprise domiciled in New Zealand.

### Tendering Format

1. Tenders are to be made by letter.
2. The following information must be given:
  - (a) Name and address of tenderer;
  - (b) Number of units tendered;
  - (c) Amount per litre of the bid.

### Advice and Publication

1. Following the closure of the tenders, bids will be publicly opened in the office of the Collector of Customs in Nelson, in the presence of a Justice of the Peace.
2. Successful tenderers will receive an Australian Tariff Quota Allocation which will show the c.i.f. value of the wine which may be imported and the concession rate of duty applicable.
3. Unsuccessful tenderers will be notified by letter.
4. The name and allocation of all tenderers, successful and invalid, and the amount of bid in each case will be published in the *Gazette* as soon as possible after the opening of the tenders.

### Gas Act 1982

#### Safety Requirements for Gas Distribution and Installations and LPG Installations

Pursuant to section 61 of the Gas Act 1982 and to regulations 12 and 37 of the Gas Industry Regulations 1984, I, Sayeed Mehdi Yassaie, hereby give notice that, subject to any other specific approval given by me:

1. Only such pipes, gas appliances and gas installations falling within the scope of the Codes of Practice specified in the Schedule hereto, are approved for the purposes of the Gas Act 1982; and
2. Only such methods of operation and maintenance of such approved pipes, gas appliances and gas installations as comply with the said codes, are approved for the purposes of the Gas Act 1982.

These approvals become effective on the dates given in the Schedule.

For the purpose of this approval the term "Authority" where it is used in those Codes shall be:

- (a) In the case of reticulated gas the appropriate gas supplier;
- (b) In all other cases either:
  - (i) The installer of the equipment; or
  - (ii) Such other person that I may notify in writing to the installer of the equipment.

Note: The effect of this notice is to;

(1) Replace the GANZ Reticulation Code 1976 with a New Zealand Standard. (The Standard has been completed but will not be printed until June 1989).

(2) Replace the GANZ Installation Code, 1976 and Industrial Installation Codes, Parts 1 and 2, 1977 with a new

GANZ Installation Code 1989. This code is an interim measure until it is published as a New Zealand Standard.

(3) Introduce an LPGANZ Installation Code for LPG installations.

The notice published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 142, page 3269 on 1 August 1985 will be revoked on 1 July 1989.
