The consultations are to relate to past trends and likely developments in inflation, the distribution of incomes from all sources, the competitiveness of New Zealand industry, the implications of the Government's fiscal and monetary policies, the employment situation and such other matters as the conference may determine.

Section 128 of the Labour Relations Act 1987 provides that the conference is also to be a forum for consultations about the interests of the low-paid and methods by which their interests may be protected. In this respect the consultations will relate to wages and other remuneration and conditions of employment, the rates of social security benefits, rates of taxation, and the appropriate mix of Government spending, taxation and wage policies required to protect the interests of the low-paid (including the effectiveness of the mechanism by which the minimum wage is fixed and the level of the

minimum wage and other minimum standards governing the employment of workers and State employees).

Any person may make written submissions in relation to the subject matter of the conference. Submissions should be addressed to the Minister of Labour, Parliament Buildings, Wellington. All submissions received will be made available to those participating in the consultations at the conference.
