**Summary of Bills Introduced****Postal Services Amendment Bill**

This Bill amends section 3 of the principal Act in relation to exemptions from current restrictions on carriage of letters for hire or reward other than by New Zealand Post. The exemption for letters of 500 grams or less is amended to 200 grams or less if a charge of:

\$1.25 is made during the 12 months ending 30 November 1990; and

\$1.00 is made during the next 12 months; and

80 cents is made thereafter.

The Bill also provides for detailed information to be supplied in the annual financial report of NZ Post.

*Vegetables Levy Amendment Bill*

This Bill increases from .375 percent of the sale price to 1 percent of the sale price the maximum amount of the levy payable under the principal Act in respect of vegetables sold commercially otherwise than for processing or canning.

Submissions apart from clause 3 in respect of proposed new section 3 (4A) of the principal Act which deals with the fixing of a levy are invited from interested parties and organisations.

#### Fisheries Act 1983

##### Fisheries (Species and Area Prohibition) Notice 1989, No. 4937

Pursuant to section 65 (1) of the Fisheries Act 1983, and delegations made pursuant to sections 28 and 41 of the State Sector Act 1988, the Director (Operations), MAFFish hereby gives the following notice:

#### Notice

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Species and Area Prohibition) Notice 1989.

(2) This notice shall come into effect on the 1st day of October 1989.

**2. Interpretation**—In this notice:

(a) Any reference to a Quota Management Area means the appropriate Quota Management Area as defined in the Fisheries (Quota) Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986;

(b) The words "New Zealand fisheries waters" have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Fisheries Act 1983.

**3. Restrictions on fishing**—As from the date this notice comes into effect until the 30th day of September 1990 (hereinafter called "the period"), it shall be a condition of all fishing permits issued or renewed during the period that the holder of the permit is prohibited from fishing in the following fisheries:

## Energy

### Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976

#### Notice of Prohibition

1. Pursuant to regulation 8 of the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976, notice is hereby given that the apparatus described below, in my opinion constitutes or may constitute an electrical hazard and is unsuitable for use in New Zealand.

1. **Description: Greenhouse Motorised Ventilator Operating Unit** consisting of the following components:

1. A Nissei Ind Ltd. GLMN -18, 1.240 ratio, 40 W 4 pole, single phase, 0.25A, 5.8 rpm. Nissei GTR geared motor.

2. An unmarked PVC enclosure containing direction control relays and 12 way terminal strip, motor brake rectifier, thermal overload device and 2uf motor winding phase displacement capacitor.

3. An unmarked PVC enclosure, containing two travel limiting micro switches, mounted on the extended motor shaft, outside the drive sprocket.

**Construction:** The motor and the two associated PVC enclosures are mounted on or adjacent the steel frame parallel to the vent drive shaft. One end of the frame has a bushed sleeve through which the ventilator drive shaft passes. The other end of the frame is supported by a chain linking the motor drive sprocket to a larger diameter sprocket fixed to the ventilator drive shaft. The vents which run full length of the greenhouse and are linked to the drive shaft via a rack and pinion system. Generally one motor is provided for each ventilator, which is hinged from the apex of a pitched roof.

The PVC enclosure containing the two control relays for the changing of the motor direction, is mounted on the steel frame at the side of and parallel with the motor to open and close the ventilator of the greenhouse through the upper and lower limiting micro switches which are mounted in a separate PVC enclosure on the motor shaft.

The motor is supplied for connection to the 230 volt supply by a 3 pin flat pin plug and flexible cord from a 3 pin switched socket outlet when installed. The control voltage is provided from a looping connection from the incoming phase terminal to the control phase terminal, as a stand alone unit using a common neutral.

These units are designed to work on a manual control basis and are provided with a cord pendant push button station suspended from the PVC control box for the opening and closing of the vents.

**Faults:** Some of the known faults are as follows:

a. The unit is not earthed in acceptable manner nor are they of double insulated type construction.

b. No wiring diagram or makers instruction supplied to show connections thus creating a possible hazard or likely to create a hazard when interconnecting other interrelated equipment.

c. Method of control not suited for multi-unit motor installations without modification.

d. Unit not marked in accordance with an approved standard.

e. Supply or control terminals not identified.

f. Micro switches connections not identified.

g. Internal wiring not numbered or colour coded consistent with any standard type.
