Marine Mammals Protection Act 1978

Notice of Intention to Amend the Marine Mammals Protection (Banks Peninsula Sanctuary) Notice 1988

I hereby give notice of my intention to amend the Marine Mammals Protection (Banks Peninsula Sanctuary) Notice 1988 so as to—

- (a) Define a "flounder area" within the sanctuary to which that notice relates; and
- (b) Allow set nets for flounder to be used at any time of the day or night (between 1 March and 31 October) within the flounder area; and
- (c) Allow set nets up to 60 metres long to be used for flounder within the flounder area; and
- (d) Allow set nets for flounder to be set and left unattended within the flounder area; and
- (e) Substitute, for the requirement that a set net that is set in the sanctuary from a boat should remain attached to the boat, a requirement that a boat from which a set net is set in the sanctuary must remain crewed, and in sight of and

not more than 50 metres from the net, while the net remains set.

The flounder area will comprise the areas of the sea that are on the landward side of the following lines:

- (a) A line in Akaroa Harbour between grid 059103 (Green Point) and grid 038118 (Ohae) on map N36 (NZMS 260):
- (b) A line in Port Levy between grid 968289 (jetty) and 955289 (wharf) on that map:
- (c) A line in Pigeon Bay between grid 024268 (Teopopaka Point) and grid 013268 on that map:
- (d) A line in Lyttelton Harbour between grid 867302 (Hays Bay) and grid 831325 on map M36 (NZMS 260).

Section 22 (1) of the Marine Mammals Protection Act 1978 requires me to consider, before varying, redefining, or abolishing a sanctuary declared under that section, any submissions in writing I may have received within 28 days after the publication of a notice in the *Gazette* indicating my intention to do so.

Estate and Gifts Duties Act 1968

Administrations in Deceased Persons Estates— Exemption Under Section 43 (1A) Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968

Pursuant to section 43 (1A) of the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968, the Commissioner of Inland Revenue gives notice that the following administrations are exempted from the requirement imposed by section 43 (1) of that Act that they be delivered to the Commissioner from the Court:

Administrations granted to the administrators of the estates of persons dying on or after 1 April 1984 where the final balance, as defined by the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968, does not exceed the amount of \$300,000.

Pursuant to section 43 (1B), the granting of this exemption is conditional in each case upon the provision to the Registrar or other proper officer of the Court of a declaration in the form specified in this notice. The declaration may be made by one or more of the administrators, or the solicitor(s) for the administrator(s), or an authorised officer of the Public Trust Office, the office of the Maori Trustee, or a Trustee Company.

The form of declaration is as follows:

Solemnly and sincerely declare that:

1. I am/We are the solicitor(s)/Administrator(s) of the estate of \ldots who died on \ldots

2. Of my/our knowledge and as a result of full enquiries made by me/us I am/we are satisfied that the final balance in the estate, as defined by the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968, being the total value of the property in the dutiable estate of the deceased, reduced by the sum of the allowable debts and any matrimonial home allowance and any charitable allowance, does not exceed the amount of \$300,000.

3. Accordingly, the current exemption granted to the Registrar by the Commissioner of Inland Revenue by authority of section 43 (1A) of the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968 applies to the administration of this estate.

4. The administration, being of the kind described in the notice of exemption by the Commissioner, is for delivery direct to the administrator(s)/solicitor(s) of the estate.
