- 3 All submissions objecting to a request for the imposition of duty must include:
- reasons why the local product on which protection is sought is not a suitable alternative;
  - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the port where the application was lodged quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.
- 5 Any submission not supported by the information required in the paragraphs above will not be regarded as a valid objection.

## CUSTOMS EXCHANGE RATES NOTICE (NO. 12) 1990

Pursuant to section 143 of the Customs Act 1966, the Comptroller of Customs, in accordance with the power delegated to him by the Minister of Customs under section 9 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 12) 1990.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 4th day of June 1990.

2. Exchange rates - Where under any provisions of the Customs Act 1966 any amount which is required to be taken into account for the purpose of assessing duty or any other purpose is not an amount in New Zealand currency, the amount to be so taken into account shall be the equivalent in New Zealand currency of that amount ascertained in accordance with the rate of exchange set out in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Revocation - The Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 11) 1990, published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, Customs Edition No. 71, dated 8 May 1990, on page 1546 is hereby revoked.
