Planning and Development

Summary of Bills Introduced

Sugar Loaf Islands Marine Protected Area Bill

This Act provides for the setting up and management of the Sugar Loaf Islands Marine Protected Area for the purpose of protecting that area of the sea and foreshore in its natural state as a habitat of marine life for the enhancement of recreational activities.

The Sugar Loaf Marine Protected Area is to be maintained in a natural state and the public to have right of entry. Restrictions will be placed on fishing around Sugar Loaf Islands and the protected area to be deemed a conservation park as defined by section 19 of the Conservation Act 1987.

Napier City Council (Control of Skateboards) Empowering

This Bill empowers the Napier City Council to make bylaws controlling the use of skateboards on any road or public place.

Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries Amendment Bill

This Bill amends the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries Act 1953. Most of the Ministry's functions will now be determined by the Crown.

The fact that the Ministry, the Minister, and the Director-General have the powers, duties, and functions of the former Marketing Department, Minister of Marketing, and Director of Marketing, does not limit or affect the Department's functions or the Minister's powers.

The Bill also enables the Minister to ratify a doubtful contract entered into by the Minister at some time in the past if, at the time of ratification, the Ministry has the appropriate functions or the Minister has the appropriate powers.

Broadcasting and Radiocommunications Reform Bill

This bill amends the Broadcasting Act 1989 and the Radiocommunications Act 1989.

The amendments proposed to the Broadcasting Act 1989 include restricting the meaning of broadcaster to a person providing transmission services in a position to exercise control, either alone or in association with others, of the operations of the company broadcasting programmes or the management of any broadcasting station operated by that company or the programmes broadcast by that company or the selection or provision of programmes to be broadcast. The responsible Minister is changed from the Minister of Broadcasting to the Minister of Communications.

The bill provides for amendments relating to Parliamentary election programmes including the following: (a) The obligation on broadcasters to provide to political parties free of charge a specified amount of broadcasting time is removed: (b) The Minister may invite broadcasters to permit parties to broadcast election programmes free of charge or at discounted rates in an election period, specifying conditions on the broadcaster's reply to the invitation: (c) The Broadcasting Authority is responsible for allocating to political parties the time offered by broadcasters but must consider whether proposals made by broadcasters can be adopted either in full or with modifications: (d) Money is to be appropriated by Parliament for allocation to political parties to meet costs of broadcasting election programmes: (e) Simulcasting of every opening address and closing address is not required but they are to be broadcast on all free-to-air television broadcasting stations made available for the purpose and on National Radio.

The bill provides for amendments to the Radiocommunications Act 1989 to enable regulations to provide for the waiver of any fees prescribed by any such regulations, and to correct an error in the lay-out of the definition of the term "gross income".

Business Development Boards Bill

This Bill provides for the establishment of Business Development Boards. Each Board is to be established in respect of a region to be specified in the Order in Council establishing the Board. The functions of the Boards are:

- (a) To advise the Minister of Regional Development on matters relating to business in the Board's region:
- (b) To promote business growth in the Board's region by undertaking the activities specified in the charter.

The charter must state:

- (a) The goals of the Boards; and
- (b) The activities the Boards are to undertake; and
- (c) The rules and guidelines applying to the operations of Boards.

The Fisheries (Cancellation of Crown Quota for Orange Roughy) Notice 1990 No. 3 (Notice No. 5010)

Notice

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Cancellation of Crown Quota for Orange Roughy) Notice 1990 No. 3.

(2) This notice shall come into effect at the same time as the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 7 is effective.

2. Interpretation—In this notice any reference to a quota management area means the appropriate quota management area as defined in the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986.

3. Cancellation of Crown Holdings of Orange Roughy Quota—(1) Pursuant to section 28U of the Fisheries Act 1983, Crown holdings of 378 tonnes of individual transferrable quota for orange roughy in the quota management area as set out following are hereby cancelled:

(2) This cancellation is in addition to that made in the Fisheries (Cancellation of Crown Quota for Orange Roughy) Notice 1990 No. 2 (Notice No. 4995).

(3) The total allowable commercial catch for orange roughy in that area is accordingly reduced by 378 tonnes as part of the Total Allowable Commercial Catch reduction for that area effected by clause 3 of the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 7.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Goods of Australian Origin No Longer Subject to Anti-dumping Duty

As a result of the enactment of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Amendment Act 1990, the following goods are no longer subject to anti-dumping duty, with effect from 1 July 1990:

"Arc welding electrodes for electric welding, manufactured by Cigweld, a division of Commonwealth Industrial Gases Ltd., Australia" as notified in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 4 June 1987.

"Certain unworked aluminium sheet, (excluding enclosure sheet and can body stock) plate, (excluding tread plate) and coil, (excluding coil stock for venetian blinds and opossum guard coil) of 0.2mm thickness and above, of various alloys, tempers and dimensions" manufactured by Comalco Aluminium Ltd. of Australia and Austral Bronze Crane Copper Ltd. of Australia as notified in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 2 February 1988.

"Aluminium passenger catamarans of 18 metres in length or longer" manufactured by North Queensland Engineers and Agents Pty. Ltd., Australia as notified in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 4 March 1988.

"Bollard pull harbour tugs, being goods of a class or kind manufactured or intended to be manufactured in New Zealand" manufactured by Carrington Slipways Pty. Ltd., Australia as notified in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 15 March 1990.

Note

The removal of anti-dumping measures in relation to goods of Australian origin follows from agreement between the Governments of New Zealand and Australia under ANZCERTA that anti-dumping measures against goods the origin of either member state be removed, with reliance instead on competition laws to deal with anti-competitive behaviour in trans-Tasman trade.

The obligation to pay any countervailing duty remains on goods of Australian origin where a valid notice imposing the countervailing duty is in force.

The obligation to pay anti-dumping duty incurred up to 1 July 1990 also remains.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 2nd day of July 1990

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Whereas, on the 25th day of July 1985, Ross Gary Appelgren was convicted in the High Court at Auckland on a charge of murdering D'Arcy Clement Te Hira and was sentenced to imprisonment for life:

And whereas an application, dated the 16th day of October 1989, has been made by Ross Gary Appelgren for the exercise of the mercy of the Crown in respect of that conviction upon the grounds (among others)—

- (a) That at the time of his trial two Police job sheets existed which were not available to Ross Gary Appelgren, or his counsel, at his trial and which contained a record of what a witness said when interviewed shortly after the attack on D'Arcy Clement Te Hira; and
- (b) That, at the time of his trial, a note apparently in the handwriting of the same witness existed which was not available to Ross Gary Appelgren, or his counsel, at his trial and which purports to record what the witness knew about the attack on D'Arcy Clement Te Hira; and
- (c) That the statements apparently made by the witness and set out in the Police job sheets and in the handwritten note are in conflict with the evidence (which was given by the witness at the trial of Ross Gary Appelgren) that the witness saw the attack on D'Arcy Clement Te Hira; and
- (d) That, having regard to the evidence given at the trial and to the contents of the job sheets and the handwritten note, the said Ross Gary Appelgren ought not to have been convicted of murder:

And whereas it appears that evidence is available which could lead the Court of Appeal to the conclusion that the trial was unsatisfactory and that a miscarriage of justice might have occurred:
