Pursuant to the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### Order

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Eastland Rural Fire District Order 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after its notification in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, the "Act" means the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977; the "Committee" means the Eastland Rural Fire Committee; "District" means the Eastland Rural Fire District.

#### Constitution of the Eastland Rural Fire District

3. The areas specified in the Schedule to this order are hereby constituted and declared to be a rural fire district to be known as the Eastland Rural Fire District.

4. The Eastland Rural Fire District shall, for the purposes of the Act, be administered by a rural fire committee which shall be known as the Eastland Rural Fire Committee.

5. The Committee shall consist of five members as follows:

- Two persons appointed by Hikurangi Forest Farms Limited by writing signed on behalf of that company by one director and the secretary thereof;
- One person appointed by P.F. Olsen and Company Limited by writing signed on behalf of that company by one director and the secretary thereof;
- One person appointed by the Director-General of the Department of Conservation; and
- One person appointed by the Chief Executive of the Gisborne District Council.

#### Schedule

##### *Gisborne and Hawke's Bay Land Districts—Gisborne, Wairoa and Opotiki Districts—Eastland Rural Fire District*
