#### Broadcasting Act 1989

**Direction to Broadcasting Commission in Relation to Funding of Aotearoa Maori Radio**

To the Broadcasting Commission—

Pursuant to section 44 of the Broadcasting Act 1989, I, Maurice Donald Williamson, Minister of Communications,—

(1) Give you notice that it is part of the general policy of Government in relation to broadcasting—

(a) That Maori broadcasting should be actively promoted and that funds be made available from the Public Broadcasting Fee revenue for this purpose; and

(2) In pursuant of that policy, direct that you shall—

(a) Make available funding of \$120,000 (exclusive of Goods and Services Tax) to the Aotearoa Maori Radio Trust Board each month for the period from and including 1 February 1991 to 30 June 1991 to broadcast nationally using the AM frequencies which have been provided for that purpose by the Crown; and

(b) Make available funding of \$108,000 (exclusive of Goods and Services Tax) to the Aotearoa Maori Radio Trust Board each month for the period from and including 1 July 1991 to 30 June 1992 to broadcast nationally using the AM frequencies which have been provided for that purpose by the Crown.

### Water Recreation Regulations 1979 State Sector Act 1988

#### The Water Recreation (West Coast Rivers) Notice 1991

I, Thomas Edwin Law, Senior Administration Officer (Harbours Management), pursuant to the Water Recreation Regulations 1979\* and in exercise of powers delegated to me, pursuant to section 28 of the State Sector Act 1988, hereby give the following notice:

#### Notice

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Water Recreation (West Coast Rivers) Notice 1991.

(b) This notice shall come into force 14 days after publication

in the *New Zealand Gazette* and shall remain in force until revoked by further notice in the *Gazette*.

2. Subject to the conditions set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, regulations 7 (1) (a), 7 (1) (b) and 7 (2) of the Water Recreation Regulations 1979, shall not apply to the area specified in the First Schedule.

3. The Water Recreation (Westland Rivers) Notice 1986† and the Water Recreation (Nelson Rivers) Notice 1977‡ are hereby revoked.

#### First Schedule

1. *Heaphy River*—All the waters of the Heaphy River from source to sea.

2. *Oparara River*—All the waters of the Oparara River from source to Blue Duck Creek confluence.

3. *Karamea River*—All the waters of the Karamea River from source to sea.

4. *Little Wanganui River*—All the waters of the Little Wanganui River from source to Splinter Creek Lime Quarry.

5. *Mokihinui River*—All the waters of the Mokihinui River from source to sea.

6. *Buller River*—All the waters of the Buller River and tributaries from the Mangles River confluence to the State Highway bridge at Westport.

7. *Totara River*—All the waters of the Totara River from source to State Highway 6 bridge.

8. *Nile River*—All the waters of the Nile River from source to sea.

9. *Grey River*—Firstly, all the waters of the Grey River and tributaries from source to the rail bridge at Greymouth, excepting the Arnold River during the period 1 May to 30 September of any year;

Secondly, all the waters of the Grey River and tributaries from the Grey/Robinson Rivers confluence to the rail bridge at Greymouth excepting the Arnold and Haupiri Rivers during the period 1 October of any one year to 30 April of the following year.

10. *New River*—All the waters of the New River from source to sea.

11. *Taramakau River*—All the waters of the Taramakau River and tributaries from source to sea.

12. *Hokitika River*—All the waters of the Hokitika River from source to sea excepting thereout Mahinapua Creek.

13. *Waitaha River*—All the waters of the Waitaha River and tributaries from source to sea.

14. *Wanganui River*—All the waters of the Wanganui River from source to sea.

15. *Poerua River*—All the waters of the Poerua River from source to sea.

16. *Whataroa River*—All the waters of the Whataroa River from source to sea.

17. *Waitangi-Taona River*—All the waters of the Waitangi-Taona River from Graham Creek to the sea excluding the Waitangiroti River.

18. *Waihao River*—All the waters of the Waihao River from source to sea.

19. *Cook River*—All the waters of the Cook River from source to sea.

20. *Karangarua River*—All the waters of the Karangarua River and tributaries from source to sea.

21. *Jacobs River*—All the waters of the Jacobs River from source to sea.

22. *Paringa River*—All the waters of the Paringa River including tributaries from source to sea.

23. *Moeraki River*—All the waters of the Moeraki River from source to sea.

24. *Haast River*—All the waters of the Haast River and tributaries from source to sea.

25. *Okuru River*—All the waters of the Okuru River from source to sea.

26. *Turnbull River*—All the waters of the Turnbull River from source to sea.

27. *Waiatoto River*—All the waters of the Waiatoto River from source to sea.

28. *Arawata River*—All the waters of the Arawata River and tributaries from source to sea.

29. *Cascade River*—All the waters of the Cascade River from source to sea.

### Second Schedule

1. Notwithstanding any other provision of this notice, no person who is permitted by any such provision to propel or navigate a small craft at a speed through the water exceeding 5 knots shall do so in any manner that is likely to endanger or

unduly annoy any person who is, in, on, or using the waters or fishing, or undertaking any recreational activity in the vicinity of the small craft.

2. All persons in charge of a vessel shall adhere to and keep the provisions of all Acts and regulations not specifically exempted by this notice.

3. Suitable notice as may be approved by the Section Officer (Harbours Management), Christchurch, shall be erected at the sites deemed necessary by the Section Officer (Harbours Management).

## Authorities and Other Agencies of State

### Broadcasting Standards Authority

#### Broadcasting Act 1989

#### Broadcasting Standards Authority—Decision No. 5/91, 6/91, 7/91, 8/91 and Interlocutory Decision 1/90

Pursuant to section 15 (1) of the Broadcasting Act 1989, notice is hereby given that the Broadcasting Standards Authority has made the following Decisions on complaints referred to it for investigation and review:

- (i) In Decision 5/91, the Authority declined to uphold a complaint by Anna Coffey of Auckland that the action taken by Television New Zealand Ltd. when upholding Ms Coffey's complaint about the good taste and decency of the film *The Big Doll House* was inadequate and unreasonable.
- (ii) In Decision 6/91, the Authority declined to uphold a complaint by Mr A. N. Dewar of Wellington that the broadcast of TV3 Network Services Ltd. of news items on 16 November 1990 and 3 December 1990 concerning the Gulf crisis breached the responsibility placed on broadcasters to discourage the portrayal of persons or sections of the community in a manner which encourages denigration of or discrimination against them.
- (iii) In Decision 7/91, the Authority upheld a complaint by Liam Wright of Auckland that the broadcast by Television

New Zealand Ltd. of an item on the *Holmes* programme about the Cartwright Report into cervical cancer treatment at the National Women's Hospital in Auckland breached the responsibility placed on broadcasters to be truthful and accurate on points of fact. The Authority ordered Television New Zealand Ltd. to broadcast, before the 22 March between 6 p.m. and 7 p.m., a brief summary of its decision.

- (iv) In Decision 8/91, the Authority upheld a complaint by Shirley Early of Auckland that the broadcast by Radio Pacific Ltd. of certain comments by Allan Dick about a committed patient at Carrington Hospital breached the responsibility placed on broadcasters to be truthful and accurate on points of fact in news and current affairs programmes.
- (v) In Interlocutory Decision 1/90, the Authority, pursuant to section 13 (1) (c) of the Broadcasting Act 1989, ordered that the complaint by the New Zealand Immigration Service against Television New Zealand Ltd. with regard to an item broadcast on the *Holmes* programme be referred back to the broadcaster for proper consideration and determination.
