Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Final Determination: Dumping Investigation in Respect of Plasterboard from Thailand, Amendment No. 2 (Duty Reassessment)

Pursuant to section 14 of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 ("the Act"), the Minister of Commerce, having carried out a reassessment of anti-dumping duty in respect of imports into New Zealand of certain plasterboard from Thailand and having determined a new anti-dumping duty applicable to those goods, gives the following notice.

Notice

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Final Determination: Dumping Investigation in Respect of Plasterboard from Thailand, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the notice entitled "Final Determination: Dumping Investigation in Respect of Plasterboard from Thailand" dated 21 December 1989 and published in the Gazette of 11 January 1990* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- (2) The reassessed anti-dumping duty, set out in the Schedule to this notice, shall apply in relation to imports of the goods specified in the said Schedule with effect from 18 April 1991.
- 2. Amendment to anti-dumping duty applicable—(1) The principal notice (as amended by notice in the Gazette of 8 March 1990 entitled "Final Determination: Dumping Investigation in Respect of Plasterboard from Thailand, Amendment No. 1") is hereby amended by omitting the Schedule and substituting the Schedule to this notice.
- 3. Consequential revocation—The notice entitled "Final Determination: Dumping Investigation in Respect of Plasterboard from Thailand, Amendment No. 1", and published in the Gazette of 8 March 1990, is hereby revoked. *Gazette of 11 January 1990.

The anti-dumping duty which is to be charged, collected and paid on demand of the Collector in respect of each importation of plasterboard-

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice amends, by substituting an amended schedule, the final determination in relation to plasterboard from Thailand which was made by the Minister of Commerce on 21 December 1989 and published in the Gazette of 11 January 1990 (as amended by notice in the Gazette of 8 March 1990 entitled "Final Determination: Dumping Investigation in Respect of Plasterboard from Thailand, Amendment No. 1). The substitution is made as a result of a reassessment of antidumping duty carried out pursuant to section 14 (3A) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988. The amended duty applicable to the imported plasterboard is to be calculated by comparing the actual export price with a non-injurious import price level, rather than the previous method of levying a flat rate of duty.

Fair Trading Act 1986

Notice Prohibiting Supply of Disappearing Ink, Fade-Away Ink and Similar Fluids

Pursuant to section 31 (3) of the Fair Trading Act 1986, I, the Honourable Katherine Victoria O'Regan, the Minister of Consumer Affairs, by this notice, which shall come into force the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*, prohibit indefinitely the supply of the goods specified in the Schedule to this notice.

- (a) Plastic or other containers of liquid described as "Disappearing Ink";
- (b) Plastic or other containers of liquid described as "Fade-Away Ink";
- (c) Any other plastic or other container of liquid having a pH less than pH3 or greater than pH10 and intended for squirting by children during play.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the notice but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice prohibits indefinitely the supply of certain liquids intended for squirting by children during play. The notice applies to liquids known as "Disappearing Ink", "Fade-Away Ink" and to any other liquid having a pH less than pH3 or greater than pH10 and which is intended for squirting by children during play.

These fluids were declared by the Unsafe Goods (Disappearing Ink and Fade-Away Ink) Notice 1989* to be unsafe goods under section 31 of the Fair Trading Act 1986. By virtue of section 31 (2) of that Act that notice expired on 12 November 1990.

Section 31 (3) of the Fair Trading Act 1986 authorises the Minister of Consumer Affairs, if 18 months has elapsed since goods were declared to be unsafe goods and if no product safety standard has been declared in respect of those goods under section 29 of that Act, to prohibit the sale of the goods indefinitely or for a specified period.

It is an offence under the Fair Trading Act 1986 to supply, or offer to supply, or advertise to supply, goods, the supply of which is prohibited under that Act.

Section 33 of that Act also prohibits the importation of such goods into New Zealand.

Indecent Publications Act 1963

Ex Parte Application For an Interim Restriction Order

In the matter of the Indecent Publications Act 1963, and in the matter of an application by the Comptroller of Customs for a decision in respect of an ex parte application pursuant to section 14A of the Indecent Publications Act 1963:

In respect of the following publications: *Electric Blue*, Vol. 1, No. 7 (IND 68/90); *Electric Blue*, Vol. 1, No. 8 (IND 79/90); *Electric Blue*, Vol. 1, No. 9 (IND 79/90). Publisher: Electric Publications Ltd.

Decision

In decision 57/90, which was delivered on 24 October 1990, the Tribunal classified *Electric Blue*, Vol. 1, No. 3, 4 and 5 as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years. In the same decision, being satisfied as to the consistency and format of those 3 issues of this serial publication, the Tribunal granted it a restriction order under section 15A of the Act. That decision and order having been notified in the *Gazette* on Thursday, 20 December 1990, the restriction order came into force on Friday, 21 December 1990. In terms of subsection (2) of section 15A of the Act that restriction order, which shall remain in force for a period not exceeding 2 years, shall apply only to those issues of this publication which are published while it is in force.

The subject publications were imported into New Zealand

before the restriction order granted in decision 57/90 came into force on 21 December 1990. Clearly, because they were not "published while the order is in force", they cannot be accorded standing thereunder. Therefore the Comptroller of Customs, quite correctly in my view, is of the opinion that the subject publications must be submitted to the Tribunal for a decision as to their classification under the Act. They have been submitted accordingly under section 14 of the Act. Pending their classification following a sitting of the Tribunal, the Comptroller of Customs has asked me to give consideration to the making of an interim restriction order under section 14A of the Act. It is provided in subsection (1) (a) of section 14A of the Act that an ex parte application for an interim restriction order in respect of any book may be made to the Tribunal by the Comptroller of Customs in any case where a book has been submitted to the Tribunal in accordance with section 14 of the Act "and the Tribunal has not announced its decision on the book ...". That is the current status of the subject publications. Subsection (4) (a) and (b) of section 14A together provide that every interim restriction order come into force on the day on which it is made and, unless sooner revoked, shall remain in force until expiry of notice or determination of any appeal thereagainst. Given that an interim restriction order shall come into force on the day on which it is made, I am satisfied as to the propriety of this application against the background of its parent restriction order coming into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

In classifying *Electric Blue*, Vol. 1, No. 3, 4 and 5 in decision 57/90 the Tribunal commented that it was:

"... satisfied that there is a consistency of format and content in respect of this publication of the kind that it is appropriate that a serial restriction order be granted classifying the publication *Electric Blue*, published by Power Radio Ltd., as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years."

Writing on behalf of the Comptroller of Customs Mr Wotherspoon has expressed the opinion that the subject publications have maintained this consistency of format and content and that they too would appear to warrant a similar classification. On this basis an interim restriction order is made accordingly classifying Electric Blue, Vol. 1, No. 7, 8 and 9 as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years. However this order is made without waiver of the Tribunal's comment in decision 57/90 that some of the photographs in this magazine, "excessively concentrated as they are on the genitalia of multiple nude female models, are such that they sicken the members of the Tribunal who consider that these photographs are both exploitative and degrading". The caution expressed in that decision, that further issues of publications previously classified as indecent in the hands of persons under a specified age in future applications before the Tribunal, can expect to receive critical re-examination in the light of changing community standards, continues to apply.

Ex Parte Application For an Interim Restriction Order

In respect of the following publications: *Penthouse Forum*, Vol. 20, No. 8 (IND 4/91); *Penthouse Forum*, Vol. 20, No. 8 (IND 82/90); *Penthouse Forum*, Vol. 20, No. 10 (IND 6/91); *Penthouse Forum*, Vol. 20, No. 11 (IND 6/91). Publisher: Forum International Ltd.

Decision

In decision 58/90, which was delivered on 24 October 1990, the Tribunal classified *Penthouse Forum*, Vol. 20, No. 20, 5, 6 and 7 as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years. In the same decision, being satisfied as to the consistency and format of those 3 issues of this serial publication, the Tribunal granted it a restriction order under section 15A of the Act. That decision and order having been notified in the *Gazette* on Thursday, 20 December 1990, the restriction order came into force on Friday, 21 December 1990. In terms of subsection (2) of section 15A of the Act that restriction order, which shall remain in force for a period not exceeding 2 years, shall apply only to those issues of this publication which are published while it is in force.

The subject publications were imported into New Zealand before the restriction order granted in decision 58/90 came into force on 21 December 1990. Clearly, because they were not "published while the order is in force", they cannot be accorded standing thereunder. Therefore the Comptroller of Customs, quite correctly in my view, is of the opinion that the subject publications must be submitted to the Tribunal for a decision as to their classification under the Act. They have been submitted accordingly under section 14 of the Act. Pending their classification following a sitting of the Tribunal, the Comptroller of Customs has asked me to give consideration to the making of an interim restriction order under section 14A of the Act. It is provided in subsection (1) (a) of section 14A of the Act that an ex parte application for an interim restriction order in respect of any book may be made to the Tribunal by the Comptroller of Customs in any case where a book has been submitted to the Tribunal in accordance with section 14 of the Act "and the Tribunal has not announced its decision on the book ...". That is the current status of the subject publications. Subsection (4) (a) and (b) of section 14A together provide that every interim restriction order come into force on the day on which it is made and, unless sooner revoked, shall remain in force until expiry of notice or determination of any appeal thereagainst. Given that an interim restriction order shall come into force on the day on which it is made, I am satisfied as to the propriety of this application against the background of its parent restriction order coming into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

In classifying *Penthouse Forum*, Vol. 20, No. 5, 6 and 7 in decision 58/90 the Tribunal commented that it was:

"... satisfied that there is a consistency of format and content in respect of the publication *Penthouse Forum* of such a kind that it is appropriate that a serial restriction order be granted classifying the publication *Penthouse Forum*, as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years. Such serial restriction order is made accordingly".

Writing on behalf of the Comptroller of Customs Mr Wotherspoon has expressed the opinion that the subject publications have maintained this consistency of format and content and that they too would appear to warrant a similar classification. On this basis an interim restriction order is made accordingly classifying *Penthouse Forum*, Vol. 20, No. 8, 9, 10 and 11 as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years.

Decision

In decision 68/90, which was delivered on 29 November 1990, the Tribunal classified XS, Vol. 3, No. 11 and 12 and Vol. 4, No. 1 as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years. In the same decision, being satisfied as to the consistency and format of those 4 issues of this serial publication, the Tribunal granted it a restriction order under section 15A of the Act. That decision and order having been notified in the Gazette on Thursday, 20 December 1990, the restriction order came into force on Friday, 21 December 1990. In terms of subsection (2) of section 15A of the Act that restriction order, which shall remain in force for a period not exceeding 2 years, shall apply only to those issues of this publication which are published while it is in force.

The subject publications were imported into New Zealand before the restriction order granted in decision 68/90 came into force on 21 December 1990. Clearly, because they were not "published while the order is in force", they cannot be accorded standing thereunder. Therefore the Comptroller of Customs, quite correctly in my view, is of the opinion that the subject publications must be submitted to the Tribunal for a decision as to their classification under the Act. They have been submitted accordingly under section 14 of the Act. Pending their classification following a sitting of the Tribunal, the Comptroller of Customs has asked me to give consideration to the making of an interim restriction order under section 14A of the Act. It is provided in subsection (1) (a) of section 14A of the Act that an ex parte application for an interim restriction order in respect of any book may be made to the Tribunal by the Comptroller of Customs in any case where a book has been submitted to the Tribunal in accordance with section 14 of the Act "and the Tribunal has not announced its decision on the book ...". That is the current status of the subject publications. Subsection (4) (a) and (b) of section 14A together provide that every interim restriction order come into force on the day on which it is made and, unless sooner revoked, shall remain in force until expiry of notice or determination of any appeal thereagainst. Given that an interim restriction order shall come into force on the day on which it is made, I am satisfied as to the propriety of this application against the background of its parent restriction order coming into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

In classifying XS, Vol. 3, No. 11 and 12 and Vol. 4, No. 1 in decision 68/90 the Tribunal commented that it was:

"... satisfied that there is a consistency of format and content in respect of the publication XS of such a kind that it is appropriate that a (sic) serial restriction order be granted classifying it as indecent in the hands of persons

under the age of 18 years. Such serial restriction order is made accordingly."

Writing on behalf of the Comptroller of Customs Mr Wotherspoon has expressed the opinion that the subject publications have maintained this consistency of format and content, apart from the comic strips entitled "Ready For It" on pages 34 and 35 of Vol. 4, No. 3 and "Sweet Medicine" in Vol. 4, No. 4. While the comic strips depict some heterosexual activity, Mr Wotherspoon said that his department considers that taking the publications as a whole, that an age restriction of indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years may be appropriate. On this basis an interim restriction order is made accordingly classifying XS, Vol. 4, No. 2, 3, 4 and 5 as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 18 years.
