 - $full\ technical\ details\ of\ the\ goods\ against\ which\ tariff\ protection\ is\ sought.$
- Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce where the application was lodged quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

# CONCESSION PROCESSING FEE

The Customs Supplement to the New Zealand Gazette dated 19 March 1991 published guidelines relating to the payment of processing fee for tariff concession applications.
