- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce where the application was lodged quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.
- 5 Any submission not supported by the information required in the paragraphs above will be considered invalid.

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 14) 1991.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 15th day of July 1991.

2.
