#### Fisheries Act 1983

#### Fisheries (Quota Aggregation Limit Exemption) Notice 1991, (No. 5109)

Pursuant to section 28w of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries, after consultation with the New Zealand Fishing Industry Board, hereby gives the following notice:

#### Notice

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Quota Aggregation Limit Exemption) Notice 1991.

(2) This notice shall come into effect on the day after its notification in the *Gazette*.

#### 2. Interpretation-In this notice:

(a) Any reference to Quota Management Area means the appropriate Quota Management Area as defined in the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches and Catch Histories) Notice 1986\*; and

(b) Species are specified by way of fishstock codes, being Fishstock Codes defined in the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 19901.

**3. Exemption to quota aggregation limit**—(1) As from the date that this notice comes into effect, the consortium of Moana Pacific Fisheries Limited, Aotearoa Fisheries Limited and the Maori Fisheries Commission are permitted to hold

quota and interest in quota in excess of the 20 percent aggregation limit for quota management areas 1 and 2 as provided in section 28w of the Fisheries Act 1983.

(2) The consortium may hold quota and interests in quota for the following species and quota management areas and up to the percentage limits as specified in the table below:

#### **Dumping and Countervailing Duties** Act 1988

#### Determination as a Specified Importer

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of Commerce, acting pursuant to section 3A (2) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, has determined that Yuasa JRA Batteries Limited, a New Zealand producer of lead automotive batteries for passenger motor vehicle market and marine applications, which is also an importer of like goods, is a 'specified importer'.

The brief reasons for this determination being made are that having regard to the nature and extent of the importations of the allegedly dumped goods including the value, quantity, frequency and purpose of the importations, the Secretary is satisfied that Yuasa JRA Batteries Limited should not be excluded from being treated as a New Zealand producer for the purposes of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988.
